The Weather



The high yesterday 65° This morning's low 41°

Today: Sunny skies with a high temperature near 65°, though the cool air and NW winds will keep things cool. Winds will be N-NW near 15-20 mph gusting to 30 mph.

Tonight: Look for mostly clear skies and a low temperature near 39° courtesy of decreasing winds and radiational cooling. Winds will be N near 10 mph.

Friday: Sunny and a high near 66°. Wind will be N at 5-15 mph gusting to 20 mph.

Overnight Friday: Clear skies with light N winds, and a low near 39°.

The weekend will bring nice weather with sunny skies and high temperatures near 70°, with lows in the 40's. The next round of showers and storms is expected on Monday and Tuesday.

Badger Baseball in Lampasas Radio Studios



Lampasas Badger Baseball Coach Chance Evans visited Lampasas Radio studios this morning, with Ace Whitehead, Gauge Gholson and Logan Coleman.

When discussing the Badgers loss to Brownwood Tuesday, Coach Evans said it was the exact opposite of the Gatesville game. The Badgers fought out of the 11-2 hole they were in to bring the score to 13-10. As the coach said "you can't expect magic every time". In Brownwood, Gauge pitched 109 times, Carson Becker 23 times, and Ace Whitehead 18 times (with 15 strikes). The Badgers habit of stealing bases was also brought up, with the Badgers stealing 10 bases in the game.

Snowid 2021

The National Weather Service released some facts about the February 2021 freeze. Facts about the February 11-12th Freezing Drizzle/Rain Event across North and Central Texas.

Freezing drizzle occurred across much of the region which led to a thin coating of nearly invisible ice on many roadways. This resulted in numerous cars sliding off the road as well as several vehicular accidents, including a 100+ cars pile-up that resulted in several fatalities on I-35 W in Fort Worth. The highest ice accumulations up to 0.5" occurred across portions of Central Texas.

Facts about the February 14-17th Winter Storm across North and Central Texas:

The official event snowfall for DFW International Airport was 5.0".

The official event snowfall for Waco Regional Airport was 4.6".

Consecutive hours at or below freezing for DFW Airport:

93 hours: 5 pm Feb 9th - 2 pm Feb 13th

139 hours: 5 pm Feb 13th - Noon Feb 19th (ties for 5th place for most consecutive hours below freezing, and ties for 8th place for most consecutive hours at or below freezing). Note: The temperature climbed to 33 degrees briefly from 2 to 5 pm on February 13th.

Consecutive hours at or below freezing for Waco Regional Airport: 205 hours: 10 pm Feb 10th - 11 am Feb 19th (new record)

This significant event impacted most of Texas and many parts of the country. The image below shows the NWS winter weather products on Sunday February 14th, 2021. Many records were broken across our home state, and Winter Storm Warnings were issued across the entire State of Texas on February 14, 2021, all 254 counties!

Records 9(historical and current) for DFW Airport and Waco Regional Airport:

The lowest low/minimum temperature was:

DFW: -2 deg F on February 16th, 2021

(All-time record low for DFW: -8 degrees F on February 12, 1899)

Waco: -1 deg F on February 16th, 2021 (All-time record low for ACT: -5 degrees F on January 31, 1949)

On February 15, DFW's high temperature was lower than the record low for the date!

Waco's snow events pushed their seasonal total to 9.0", which is the 3rd highest total on record.

The coop site at Jacksboro fell to -11 deg F on February 16. This ties the 3rd coldest temperature on record for our county warning area :

-15 deg F at Glen Rose on December 23, 1989

-12 deg F at Lampasas on January 16, 1949

-11 deg F at Jacksboro on February 16, 2021 (Also -11 deg F at Bowie on December 23, 1989 and at Hico on January 31, 1949)

In our area, Lampasas was the lowest we could find with a -1° reading on the morning of February 16th, and 4° above zero on the morning of February 15th. Gatesville hit 0° on the morning of February 16th, and Hamilton was 2° above zero.

Meeting on Disabled Veteran's Tax Exemption

The Lampasas County Commissioners' Court will have a called meeting tomorrow in the Commissioner's Courtroom in the Lampasas County Courthouse at 9am. The Commissioners will discuss/consider and take possible action on the 100% Disabled Vets Homestead Property Tax Exemption.

Last year, on February 24th at a Lampasas County Commissioners Court meeting, Judge Hoyer stated that "Lampasas County does not oppose this exemption in fact we embrace it and we recognize the veterans that have earned it and deserve it and we want to maintain it and keep it. This exemption is without a doubt by far one of the largest unfunded state mandates that we have ever seen and it is costing the county a significant amount of money because we have so many qualified veterans living in our county."

In 2015 the State Legislature recognized the financial impact that this exemption was having on Texas counties. In 2015 a new legislation was passed granting reimbursement for counties and municipalities that were negatively affected. A caveat in the reimbursement exemption, however, requires that in order to be eligible the county had to have a military installation located in the city or county. Lampasas county is 1.7 miles away from being eligible for the reimbursement." State Representative Brad Buckley is scheduled to attend this meeting, and explain the funding issues.

Cattle Market Report

Lampasas Cattle Auction's weekly sale took place Wednesday and 495 head were on hand, up from the 489 head of the last sale a week ago, and up from the 335 head a year ago at this time.

Feeder steers and heifers were steady to \$5 higher on feeders, slaughter cows were \$1-\$3 higher, and slaughter bulls were steady.
