Meeting on Disabled Veteran's Tax Exemption

The Lampasas County Commissioners Court had a called meeting this morning at 9am. Texas House Representative Dr. Brad Buckley spoke to the Commissioner's Court regarding findings to determine if Lampasas County was disproportionately affected by property tax relief for veterans. Lampasas County is currently

ineligible for state reimbursement because a military installation is not partially located in the county. Fort Hood is approximately 1.7 miles from the Lampasas County Line, however, many disabled veterans live in Lampasas County. Since passing the exemption in 2009, this discrepancy has cost Lampasas County \$4,733,475.00 in taxes.

Representative Buckley describes two clear paths forward to address to remedy this injustice. Passage of HB125 would include any counties 2 miles within the boundary of a military installation. Passage of Senator Dawn Buckingham's SB524 include expanding any counties 2 miles in the boundary with additional restriction of a population less than 200,000, and with adjacent counties having a population no greater than 1.5 million. Either bill passing would make Lampasas County eligible for state reimbursement reducing the burden on local taxpayer, tax rate, and services offered by the county.

Representative Buckley emphasized that he is 100% for earned exemptions such as 100% disabled veterans or agricultural exemptions but believes that the state should honor the spirit of the code and reimburse counties who have had significant financial impact based on boundaries.
