Local Youths Injured in Riverbank Cave-In

Lampasas Radio received the following press release: "On March 18th at approximately 5:07pm, the Lampasas County Sheriff's Office received a 911 call for assistance with an incident on the Lampasas River behind the River Place neighborhood, located in the unincorporated area of Kempner. The reporting party advised that children were down in the river digging a tunnel and while digging, the tunnel collapsed.

Lampasas County Sheriff's deputies arrived to assist with this incident. A 9 year old male was on the bank being treated by Hamilton EMS personnel and was accompanied by his mother, Brandie Sappenfield (39). A Lampasas County Sheriff's Office deputy and a Kempner Police Department officer swam across the Lampasas River, along with several other civilian bystanders, emergency medical personnel and fire personnel, to rescue the other 15 year old male. The 15 year old male had already been freed from the collapsed debris by civilians before any first responders arrived. First responders performed initial assessments and transported the 15 year old male across the river utilizing a kayak. The Lampasas River in this area is approximately six to eight feet deep."

Both males were transported to McLane Children's Hospital in Temple. The 15 year old male was in critical condition at the time of transport with a fracture in his T12 pressing on his spinal cord. The 9 year old male was in stable condition at the time of transport with multiple fractures to back, ribs and hip. This incident is still under investigation at this time.

The Cody Stephens Foundation will be on the Middle School and High School campuses March 21st to provide EKG's to students in the 6th-12th grade. The EKG's are interpreted via telemedicine by licensed cardiologists and results are returned to the school within 3 business days.

The cost of EKG's will be \$25 with \$5 of each payment going to support the HOSA program at Lampasas High School.

Forms must be turned in by March 20th for the EKG.
