The Weather



High yesterday was 68° The low this morning was 41°

Today: Sunny, with a high near 73° and SW wind around 5 mph becoming calm in the afternoon.

Tonight: Partly cloudy with a low around 48° and calm wind becoming E-SE around 5 mph in the afternoon.


Friday: Mostly sunny with a high near 74° and S-SW wind 5-10 mph. Overnight, there is a 40% chance of rain.

The Weekend: Saturday will bring a 60% chance of rain mainly after 8am in the morning. Otherwise there will be clouds and a high around 67° in the afternoon and down to 58° overnight with the 60% rain chance continuing.

Sunday rain chances are down to 20% and the daytime high should be a warm 77° with 10 mph south wind.

Next Week: The 20% rain chance should go away before 8am Monday morning and we'll see a nice spring day with the temperature back in the upper 70s. That kind of nice day is likely to be around at least to mid-week.

What's Going On

 **Lampasas Badger Boys Track team is headed to Burnet this afternoon for the Bulldog Relays.** Field Events are to begin at 4pm, followed by the running events where the finals should be underway about 6pm.

Lampasas Mission has its 3rd Annual Golf Tournament on Saturday at Hancock Park. It's a 4 person scramble limited to the first 20 teams. The registration deadline is Friday at 3pm at the Mission.

The fun includes lots of prizes – closest to the pin, a car prize for anybody with a hole-in-one on 17 and lots of other prizes. It's an 8am tee time with a meal served after the tournament. Sounds like fun!

LHS is having their annual Freshman Parent Night on Tuesday evening, March 26th at the High School. The event runs from 5:30 to 7pm.

Donnell Rathman, at the age of 86, is still a Lampasas Volunteer Fireman. He has been a member of the local VFD since he was 16. That's 70 yrs of service, the apparent record for local FD.

At a reception in his honor Wednesday, we asked Donnell if he had any close competitors for the record and he mentioned another long-timer, the late John Ernest, who he thought had about 62 yrs in the department. With that 70 yrs of firefighting in Lampasas, Donnell can probably tell you about every major fire in the area since about 1950. In the picture above he's on the step of the old '72 Mack Pumper, a nice white truck that Donnell says they had out on what he called the old Barnes Lumber Co. fire. (It was actually operated by Foxworth Galbraith at the time and was later ruled as an arson fire – started by some wayward youth) The Mack, he says, is still fully operational, but they don't really use it any more. It was replaced for service by a newer model some years ago.

Hoffpaur's Outdoor Store in Burnet Shutting Down

According to Lee Hoffpaur, there have been several changes in the operation of his businesses in Central Texas and the Burnet Outdoor Store where they market small tractors and implements of all kind... just isn't a good fit any more. Therefore, the large supply of small and large tractors, over 100 lawn mowers and lots of chain saws, ATVs and more are either being moved or sold at big discounts.

Since all the products at the Burnet store are also marketed at his other stores, it just makes sense to move them to the centralized locations in Lampasas and Goldthwaite. Lee did say that some of the products would continue to be available at the Hoffy's Pawn location in Burnet, and that "service" would continue to be available for Burnet customers through the Goldthwaite store. He even committed to do a pickup and delivery service on a regular basis at the Burnet location, in order to get products to the Goldthwaite store conveniently.

Lee said that he would prefer selling the Burnet inventory at big discounts rather than have to move it, so-o, he says there are some real bargains at the Burnet Outdoor store in its last few weeks of operation.

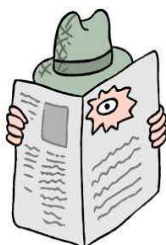
