## The Weather

High yesterday was 73° The low this morning was 47°

**Today:** Increasing clouds and a high near 75° for our last weekday. The winds will be S-SE at 5-15 mph.

**Tonight:** Rain chances are down from our earlier forecast, now looking like just 20% chance overnight. The low should be 55° and with light SE wind for those of us outside for the evening.

**Saturday:** Mostly cloudy with a 40% rain chance for our weekend start, and most of that will likely come in the afternoon or evening. The high should be about 72° and the overnight low about 61°. The rain chances continue overnight and the wind should be south at 10-15 mph.

**The Weekend:** Sunday rain chances are down to 20% and the daytime high should be a warm 79° with 10-15 mph south or SW wind.

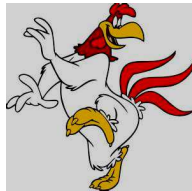

## Alarm Ordinance Reminder

The Lampasas Police Dept. sent a news release Thursday reminding us about the new alarm ordinance.

The ordinance went into effect in 2018, and residents were allowed a grace period until January 2019.

City ordinance 1559 section (2-351) states that you must have an alarm permit issued by the city, and section (2-356) covers the fines assessed by the ordinance.

Chief Bailey states that the first time officers respond to an alarm, they visit with the resident about the permits, ask for a valid permit number, and advise about the new ordinance.

Residents are allowed three false alarms, and permitted or not, on the fourth false alarm in a twelve month period, the resident is sent a summons to Municipal Court for a City Ordinance Violation. This is the case even if the alarm is permitted.

Many things can cause a false alarm. An electrical outage, or a storm for example, and these things are documented by the police department. If someone comes near your home and sets off your alarm and leaves, this will be considered a false alarm subject to City Ordinances and fines, unless there is video to support your claim.

Chief Bailey confirmed there is an appeal process for false alarms through the Lampasas Police Department, and hopes to have better efficiency in responses with the implementation of this ordinance. She invites anyone with questions to call or come by.
