The Weather

The high yesterday 81° This morning's low 68°

Today: Look for mostly cloudy skies, with a high near 80°. Wind will be S today near 15 mph with possible gusts of 25 mph.

Tonight: Look for mostly cloudy skies, and the low will get down to about 64° overnight with a 40% chance of showers and storms. The wind will be from the S near 15-20 mph gusting to 30 mph.

Friday: Cloudy in the morning with gradual clearing with a high temperature near 82° and a 50% chance of precipitation through early afternoon. Wind will be W at 10-20 mph with possible gusts of 30 mph.

Friday Night: Look for clear skies and a low near 52°. Look for the wind to be from the W near 10-15 mph with gusts of 25 mph.

Saturday: Sunny with the high temperature near 77° and N-NW wind near 15 mph with gusts as high as 30 mph.

Saturday Night: Mostly clear skies and a low near 50°. Wind will be W at 5-10 mph shifting S-SE overnight.

Grass Fire on 281South

Lampasas Volunteer Fire Department was dispatched for a grass fire on South US Highway 281 yesterday at 1:38pm. Upon arrival on scene fire personnel found the fire had spread into the neighboring property, and mutual aid was received from area fire departments and the Texas Forestry Service. The fire was named The Badger fire and contained to 5-10 acres with minimal property damage. The fire was in the same area as a controlled burn that took place the day before.



Diamondback Jubilee

While there may not be as many rattlesnakes in those hills as used to be (in 2022 only about 1/3 as many snakes were captured), the Diamondback Jubilee will roll on this weekend.

Rattlesnakes, turkey legs, cotton candy, a carnival and ridin', ropin' and rodeo. The Jubilee will begin tomorrow with the same inflatable carnival as last year, and vendors will begin to arrive in the afternoon. The Rodeo will kick off Friday night at 6:30pm with muttin' bustin' followed by the 10th Annual Diamondback Rodeo at 7:30pm. Admission to the Rodeo for either night is \$15 for adults, \$5 for kids 7-12, and kids under 6 are free. Active duty military will be admitted free with ID. Following the rodeo, Ed Sullivan and friends will play at the Rodeo Dance Friday night from 5pm to midnight.

Upcoming Election

In the City of Lampasas May 6th General Election, for the Mayor's race, Cathy Kuehne and Herb Pearce are candidates. Council Place 1 shows Zachary Morris as the only candidate, and Council Place 6 shows Charles Pratus as the only candidate. However, Place 2 for the Lampasas City Council has Robert Goodart Jr. and Eric Hernandez vying for the seat.
