**Overnight Friday:** Increasing clouds with brisk S-SE winds at 10-15 and possible gusts of 25 mph.

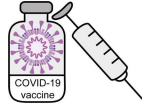
**The weekend** will bring mostly cloudy skies and high temperatures in the 70's, with lows in the 50's. There is a 20% chance of showers and storms through the weekend.
