City Council to Meet

The Lampasas City Council will meet Monday February March 27th for regularly scheduled meetings.

The Workshop Session will begin at 5:30pm and the agenda includes discussion concerning the water and electric rates and staffing for the pool season.

The Regular Session will begin immediately following the Workshop Session (possibly prior to 6pm). The Agenda includes the Consent Agenda to include discussion and possible action regarding the Specific Use Permit for 101 S. Key Ave. There will be board and departmental reports, routine matters and the City Manager's Operational Report to include information on the Skate Park, the audit, the Park Board, the Eclipse, and the Capital Improvement Plan. This will be followed by Mayor's Comments.

There will be discussion and possible action on the following: the award of bid for annual emulsion contract, a resolution authorizing the submission of the Texas Community Development Block Grant, a resolution authorizing city representative to act in matters pertaining to the Downtown Revitalization Program, a resolution to declare an area of the designated Historic Downtown/Commercial District as a blighted area, a resolution authorizing the submission of a Downtown Revitalization Program application, a resolution authorizing the signatories for the Downtown Revitalization Program application and future grants administered through Texas Dept. of Agriculture TDA Go grants online, the use of HOT funds for the 2023 Riata Roundup & LTX BBQ fest, the first reading of an Ordinance amending Chapter 54,

Parks & Recreation, Lampasas Code of Ordinances, the first reading of an Ordinance to re-adopt Chapter 50 offenses, Article II, pertaining to Curfew for Minors (required by state law every 3 years), and notice of the May 6th General Election.

The City Council will meet in Executive Session for consultation with attorney by telephone and/or in person concerning matters upon which the attorney has a duty and/or responsibility to report to the governmental body; and/or other matters posted on the regular agenda.

The City Council will then return to regular session for action on items discussed in Executive Session.
