## The Weather

**The High yesterday 76°      The Low this morning 51°**



**Today:** Sunny, with a high near 72° and E-NE wind coming in at 5-10 mph.

**Tonight:** Clear, a low around 48° and east wind 5-10 .

**Wednesday:** Mostly sunny and up to 75° with south wind of 5-10 mph, increasing to 10-15 mph in the afternoon and gusting. Overnight, partly cloudy and down to 53°.

**The Lometa ISD Board** meets at 6:30pm today in the school library at 8<sup>th</sup> and Main in Lometa.

**Lampasas High School** will be holding their annual Freshman Parent Night this evening - 5:30 to 7pm.

**Wednesday brings the Basketball Banquet** at 6pm in the Cafetorium at Lampasas High School – an opportunity to applaud Badger players for outstanding play and in many cases, outstanding personality.

**Friday Brings** the first day of the **Lometa Diamondback Rodeo** at the Regional Park on Hwy 183/190 in Lometa.

**Saturday Brings** the opening of the **Diamondback Jubilee** in Lometa with the carnival already in place and midway tents set up early Saturday morning. The official opening is at 9am and it lasts into the night with more rodeo and a rodeo dance with Jason Roberts band coming afterward.

**Saturday also brings** the start of the two day **5 Hills Art Fest** that will continue into and thru most of Sunday.

**Saturday also brings the Saratoga Masonic Lodge's annual Lamar Medal presentations** with awards and scholarships presented. The Lamar Medal recognizes significant performance in and for education in Lometa and Lampasas schools. The Lodge, at 1209 CTE, will open for the 7pm ceremony with a number of honorees, both students and teachers.



## Monday Meetings

**Lampasas County Commissioners** met Monday morning and handled a few item agenda, one of the issues was on non-consent towing rules where Attorney Scott Cooley, representing SAS Trucking, voiced concern that a company might be called in to tow where they are not properly equipped. There was also concerned over rates, all of which brought no action for the time. There was a presentation on the Texas 4000 Atlas bike ride coming to town on June 1<sup>st</sup>. There was a proclamation declaring April as Child Abuse Prevention Month, and discussion on Burn Ban issues and whether or not there should be exemptions. County Clerk Connie Hartmann discussed records preservation and the need for funding to expand the real estate records section.



**Lampasas City Council** met last night with a workshop session which included discussion on the Atlas 4000 bicycle ride. This will be the 16<sup>th</sup> year for the event and will have 84 contestants, the largest number thus far.

During the regular session the City Council approved the new logo for the Nix water tower. It will be a "rockin L" logo with the wording "Lampasas" under the logo. Also under discussion was the subject of fiber optics. The city is considering pursuing possible loan and grant possibilities to bring in increased broadband capability.
