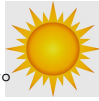

## The Weather

The High yesterday 73°

The Low this morning 47°



**Today:** The day should be sunny, with a high near 74° and with S-SE wind 10-15 mph and occasionally gusting.

**Tonight:** Mostly cloudy, with a low around 55° and with S-SE wind still coming in at 10-15 and gusting.

**Thursday:** Partly sunny, with a high near 75° and south wind at 10-20 and gusting to 25. Overnight, the temp will drop to about 58° and the wind will be brisk at 15 mph and gusting to 25.

**Rest of the week:** Friday will bring a partly sunny but warm afternoon with a high about 80°. Friday night will drop to about 56 and still a bit windy with south wind 10-15 mph.

The ever important weekend could bring scattered rains amid the partly sunny skies on Saturday. The high will be much cooler with a high about 65° and the west wind of 10-20 mph could gust even more, and then shift to north in the afternoon to make for a cool one. That will continue on Saturday night with north wind and gusts to 30 mph. Sunday could get a little better in some ways as the rain chances seem to decrease in the long term forecast, though the high will only be about 59° for Sunday if the long term guess is right. Sunday night it will get cold, dropping down to about 39°.

## Overnight Toil and Trouble in Burnet – Officer Involved Shooting

Burnet Police Chief Paul Nelson says the officer who shot and killed a man early this morning has been placed on administrative leave while investigators study the incident. The shooting took place when police worked a loud music complaint at around 1:40am this morning in the 300 block of S. McNeil St.

The Chief said the officer went toward a red car at the scene with a man and woman inside. The car started to move away and the officer yelled at the driver to stop. At some point, according to the statement, the car ran over the officer's foot and that's evidently when he shot at the driver, killing him. He then called for emergency medics who tried CPR but the man evidently died there.

Chief Nelson's statement to TV cameras was short and limited as any officer involved shooting must now be turned over to the Texas Rangers for official investigation. He did say that the officer's injuries did not involve any broken bones or serious injury. He also said that the woman in the car was released.

## Meeting Reports

**Lometa ISD School Board** held a brief meeting on Tuesday. The Board approved the 2018 financial audit, along with an alternative graduation program that will help students that didn't pass all of the TAKS or STAAR EOC tests. This will give those students a chance at graduation. Also approved at the meeting was agreement for all staff members to receive free breakfast and lunch at the school.




**Lampasas City Manager** notes that after Monday's City Council meeting the outlines for preparation of a comprehensive plan for future work and development for the City is beginning. He also discussed, in his regular 9am Wednesday morning radio interview on KACQ, that the Stone Valley subdivision plans and agreements were approved by Council. The subdivision, which required significant engineering for drainage, is to eventually contain well over 60 single family dwellings.
