## The Weather



High yesterday was 85° Low this morning was 65°

There is a slight chance for a storm today due to a nearby pacific cool front up north. This should mean a slightly cooler and drier Saturday as the rain moves off to the east. Highs tomorrow are forecast for the mid-70's, but could reach the 80's depending on the surface winds. The clearing skies will make for a cool Saturday night with 40's and 50's for the low temperatures. The rain chances reappear on Sunday.

**Today:** Mostly cloudy with a high near 86°. Wind will be S-SW at 5-15 mph.

**Tonight:** Mostly cloudy with a low near 61°. Winds will be S-SE near 10-15 mph. there is a slight chance of showers early in the morning.

**Saturday:** Mostly cloudy to begin with decreasing clouds and ending sunny with a high near 76.0 W-NW wind at will be gusty at 15-20 gusting to 25 mph.

**Saturday night:** Winds will be W near 5-10 mph. Skies will be mostly clear with a low near 48°.

**Sunday:** Mostly sunny with a high temperature near 77°. Winds will be light out of the N-NW shifting SE in the afternoon.

**Sunday night:** Mostly cloudy and a low near 58°, with E-SE winds at 5-10 mph and a 30% chance of showers and storms.

**Monday:** An 80% chance of showers and storms with a high near 74°. Winds will continue E-SE shifting to the S in the afternoon.

## Proclamation Issued

Judge Hoyer, County Judge, issued the following statement yesterday:  
Media Release  
March 26, 2020



Lampasas County Judge Issues Order in Response to COVID-19  
"There is no doubt that this is an ever-changing public health emergency. I firmly believe that Lampasas County citizens have generally complied with all of the recommendations, guidelines and orders provided by the President, CDC and Governor. I feel that what has been done so far will have a tremendous impact limiting the spread of the virus. We must constantly assess and re-assess the situation hour by hour with our first priority being public health & safety, while trying to maintain a sense of normalcy in our lives."

"With this said, I have issued an order to all Lampasas County citizens that I believe is a measured response to address the situation at this time and will further assist in limiting the spread of the virus.

The key points to the order:

- Requires social distancing of at least six feet from any person when they are outside their residence.
- Restricts gatherings in groups of more than 10.
- Prohibits dining in at restaurants and food establishments.
- Prohibits service-oriented business from performing services that require physical contact.
- Strongly encourages County residents to remain at home and limit travel to essential needs only.

## Gov. Abbot Quarantines Visitors From 4 Areas

**Governor Abbott, in a news conference yesterday, according to his website, issued an Executive Order that reads in part:**



“ mandating a self-quarantine of 14 days for individuals traveling to Texas as their final destination through an airport from the Tri-State Area of New York, New Jersey, or Connecticut as well as the city of New Orleans, Louisiana. This Executive Order is consistent with the guidance of Dr. Anthony Fauci and Dr. Deborah Birk of the White House Coronavirus Task Force and will be enforced by the Texas

Department of Public Safety (DPS). During this period, a quarantined person shall not allow visitors into or out of the designated quarantine location, other than a physician or healthcare provider, and cannot visit any public spaces. These mandatory self-quarantines will last a period of 14 days or for the duration of a person’s presence in Texas, whichever is shorter.”

“Those entering Texas as their final destination from the designated areas will use a form from DPS to designate their quarantine location. DPS special agents will conduct unannounced visits to designated quarantine locations to verify compliance. Failure to comply with this order is considered a criminal offense that is punishable by up to a \$1,000 fine, up to 180 days in jail, or both”

“This order to self-quarantine shall not apply to people traveling in connection with military service, emergency response, health response, or critical-infrastructure functions, as may be determined by the Texas Division of Emergency Management (TDEM). This Executive Order will remain in effect and in full force until modified, amended, rescinded, or superseded by the Governor”

## Disaster Information from the USDA....(NOT coronavirus)

**Emergency Support to Producers in Surrounding Counties/Border States Also Available**

WASHINGTON, March 20, 2020 — Agriculture Secretary Sonny Perdue designated 83 Texas counties as primary natural disaster areas. Producers who suffered losses due to recent drought may be eligible for U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) Farm Service Agency (FSA) emergency loans.



The Texas counties with the primary natural disaster designation include Anderson, Atascosa, Bandera, Bee, Bell, Blanco, Brazos, Brown, Burleson, Burnet, Caldwell, Callahan, Cherokee, Coke, Coleman, Colorado, Comal, Concho, Crockett, Dallam, DeWitt, Dimmit, Eastland, Edwards, Freestone, Frio, Gillespie, Glasscock, Goliad, Gonzales, Guadalupe, Haskell, Hays, Henderson, Houston, Irion, Jackson, Jim Hogg, Jones, Karnes, Kendall, Kerr, Kinney, La Salle, Lavaca, Leon, Live Oak, Llano, McCulloch, Mason, Maverick, Medina, Menard, Navarro, Nolan, Palo Pinto, Real, Runnels, San Saba, Schleicher, Shackelford, Smith, Starr, Stephens, Sterling, Taylor, Throckmorton, Tom Green, Travis, Uvalde, Val Verde, Van Zandt, Victoria, Webb, Wharton, Wichita, Wilbarger, Williamson, Wilson, Wood, Young, Zapata, and Zavala. This natural disaster designation allows FSA to extend much-needed emergency credit to producers recovering from natural disasters. Emergency loans can be used to meet various recovery needs including the replacement of essential items such as equipment or livestock, reorganization of a farming operation or the refinance of certain debts.

Producers in the contiguous Texas counties of Angelina, Archer, Austin, Bastrop, Baylor, Bexar, Brazoria, Brooks, Calhoun, Camp, Clay, Comanche, Coryell, Crane, Duval, Ellis, Erath, Falls, Fayette, Fisher, Foard, Fort Bend, Franklin, Gregg, Grimes, Hardeman, Hartley, Hidalgo, Hill, Hood, Hopkins, Howard, Hunt, Jack, Jim Wells, Kaufman, Kimble, King, Knox, **Lampasas**, Lee, Limestone, McLennan, McMullen, Madison, Martin, Matagorda, Midland, Milam, Mills, Mitchell, Moore, Nacogdoches, Parker, Pecos, Rains, Reagan, Refugio, Robertson, Rusk, San Patricio, Scurry, Sherman, Stonewall, Sutton, Terrell, Trinity, Upshur, Upton, Walker, and Washington, along with Union County, New Mexico, and Cimarron, Cotton, Jackson, and Tillman counties in Oklahoma, are also eligible to apply for emergency loans.

The deadline to apply for these emergency loans is Nov. 7, 2020. FSA will review the loans based on the extent of losses, security available and repayment ability.

FSA has a variety of additional programs to help farmers recover from the impacts of this disaster. FSA programs that do not require a disaster declaration include: Emergency Assistance for Livestock, Honeybees and Farm-Raised Fish Program; Emergency Conservation Program; Livestock Forage Disaster Program; Livestock Indemnity Program; Operating and Farm Ownership Loans; and the Tree Assistance Program.
