## The Weather



High yesterday was 76° The low this morning was 57°

**Today:** Mostly cloudy, with a high near 77° and south wind around 5-15 mph and gusty.

**Tonight:** Mostly cloudy with a low around 60° and S-SE wind will be around 15 mph and gusting to 20.

**Friday:** Partly sunny with a high near 79° and south wind will be 10-15 mph and gusting to 25. Overnight, the temp will drop to 59° and the south wind will continue.

**The Weekend:** Saturday will bring the arrival of a weak and possibly wet cold front. There should be a high around 66° in the afternoon but the wind will shift to northerly in the afternoon and it could get pretty windy, perhaps 25 mph. Overnight we will see the temperature drop to about 42°, but the rain chances don't seem to show up in the current long range forecast until late Saturday night or early Sunday morning.

The low Sunday morning should be about 42°, then it could rise to around 58° in the afternoon with N-NE wind about 15 mph and gusting. Overnight will bring a low around 42 again, with lighter NE wind.

Monday will still be a little cool, but the sun should shine.
