## The Weather

High yesterday was 78° The low this morning was 61°

**Today:** Mostly cloudy and on up to 79° this afternoon. The south wind will be brisk, 10-15 mph and gusting.

**Tonight:** Mostly cloudy skies with a low around 60° and S-SE wind 15 mph and gusty.

**Saturday:** There is a small chance of showers in the morning as the front comes in, then just mostly cloudy with a high of around 67°. The southerly wind will give up to northerly in the afternoon and the tents at the Diamondback Jubilee in Lometa will be fighting the wind for much of the day.

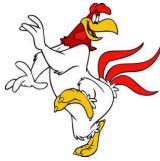


