The Weather

Today: Look for sunny skies and a high temperature near 77°. Winds will be S at 10-15 mph gusting to 20 mph. With the stronger winds, there is elevated grass fire danger.
Tonight: Look for increasing clouds and a low temperature near 56°. Winds will continue from the S at 10-15 mph, with possible gusts of 20 mph.
Tuesday: Skies will be mostly cloudy with a high temperature near 84°, and S-SW winds at 10-20 mph gusting to 30 mph.

Update on Trooper Shooting

According to KWTX in Waco, authorities said DPS Trooper Chad Walker pulled up behind a stranded motorist Friday evening outside of Mexia, but before Walker could offer help, the driver exited his vehicle and fired several rounds at the trooper's patrol unit, striking Walker in the head and abdominal area. The suspect fled on foot with a black backpack.
This is what Texas DPS shared with Lampasas Radio; "On Saturday evening, a 36-year-old man was found deceased with what is suspected to be a self-inflicted gunshot wound at a residence on Highway 84, west of Mexia, Texas. The deceased was the suspect in a shooting that injured Texas Department of Public Safety Highway Patrol Trooper Chad Walker on Friday evening.
Friends and relatives prayed for a miracle Sunday night as DPS reported Walker is "still alive and in critical condition Those closest to the Walker Family started a GoFundMe account to help the trooper's family with medical expenses and other financial needs. Vaccine Now Available to Everyone 16 Years and Over.

More than 1 million first doses of COVID-19 vaccine will be shipped to providers across Texas next week. The Texas Department of State Health Services is allocating 818,410 doses to 779 providers in 202 counties. More than 200,000 additional first doses are expected to be available to pharmacy locations and federally-qualified health centers directly from the federal government.
Texas has now administered more than 10 million doses, an increase of 1.2 million in the last week. More than 6.8 million people have received at least one dose, and almost 3.5 million are fully vaccinated. Among Texas seniors, more than six in 10 have received at least one dose, and four in 10 are now fully vaccinated. More than 30 percent of all Texans at least 16 years old have gotten at least one dose.
Beginning Monday, all Texans ages 16 and older will be eligible to receive a vaccine. Vaccination has helped drive down the number of new cases and people hospitalized with COVID-19 to their lowest level since October.
"We are closing in on 10 million doses administered in Texas, and we want to keep up the momentum as the vaccine supply increases," said Imelda Garcia, DSHS associate commissioner for laboratory and infectious disease services and the chair of the Expert Vaccine Allocation Panel. "As eligibility opens up, we are asking providers to continue to prioritize people who are the most at risk of severe disease, hospitalization and death – such as older adults." DSHS has directed vaccine providers to prioritize people 80 years old or older when scheduling appointments and accommodate anyone in that age group who presents for vaccination, whether or not they have an appointment, by immediately moving them to the front of the line. That will ensure vaccination of anyone 80 or older with as small a burden on themselves as possible.
Locally, no providers in Lampasas are scheduled to receive doses of the vaccine this week. Cattle's Pharmacy continues to make appointments in Lampasas for those who would like to be vaccinated.
