Area Wildfires

Fire Dept. officials at Ft. Hood said as of Monday night, the on-post Crittenburg fire had burned nearly 33,000 acres and was 55% contained.

The Flat Fire, a second fire outside the Ft. Hood boundary in Coryell county had burned about 300 acres and was 50% contained as of Monday night. For the town of Flat, evacuation orders have been lifted.

The Army is fighting the Crittenburg fire, while Texas A&M forestry service is helping local firefighters battle the Flat Fire on private land.

The Ft. Hood fire, reportedly started during a training exercise, saw more than 63 water airdrops by the US Fish & Wildlife service, and firefighters were using heavy equipment to cut firebreaks and they are conducting back burning operations.

More on Texas Wildfires

Emergency Crews across Texas are preparing for more wildfires to break out today. There have been 700 wildfires across the state this month, and this week's fires may outpace the containment efforts that crews have already made. Areas of concern include the panhandle and the Hill Country. Erin O'Connor with the Texas A&M Forestry Service says they've stationed extra crews in these high risk areas and brought in more equipment and tools to help as well.

O'Connor says people can help the firefighting efforts by staying inside when possible and doing their part to prevent any additional fires.
