Lampasas Police Dept. for Friday shows a quiet early morning followed by a busy day starting with a minor accident in the 2700 block of 281 S. at 6:58. Immediately after that there were 3 arrests in the 300 block of E 4th St. as three men, all 18 years of age, all from Lampasas were arrested on Lampasas PD warrants for Theft of property over \$750/under \$2500. At 8:30am a criminal mischief was reported in the 200 block of E. Ave A, then at 8:43am there was a burglary of a motor vehicle in the 800 block of N. Key. Suspicious activity was reported at the SueAnn Park at 9:13am, then a fraud report came in at 10:17am in the 200 block of S. Key.

A domestic disturbance was reported in the 1700 block of CTE at 11:40am. A reckless driver was reported in the 1000 block of W. 1st at 12:31pm, then a suspicious person report came in from the 300 block of E. 4th St. at 12:44pm. Butler has been with the police department for three years and was just recently promoted to patrol Sargent. The deceased in the shooting has been identified as Burnet County resident Brandon Michael Jacque, age 25.

The Texas Rangers are continuing the investigation. No further details of the investigation will be released at this time.”
