## The Weather



**The high yesterday 70° This morning's low 57°**

**Today:** Look for cloudy skies, with a high near 76° and a 30% chance of showers and storms. Wind will be S-SE today near 15-20 mph with possible gusts of 30 mph.

**Tonight:** Look for mostly cloudy skies, and the low will get down to about 65° overnight with a 20% chance of showers and storms. The wind will be from the S near 15-20 mph gusting to 35 mph.

**Friday:** Mostly cloudy in the morning with gradual clearing and a high temperature near 85°. Wind will be S at 15-20 mph shifting W-NW in the afternoon. Wind gusts of 35 mph are possible.

**Friday Night:** Look for mostly clear skies and a low near 49°. Wind will be W-NW near 5-15 mph with gusts of 20 mph.

## District Court Notes

**Lampasas County Courthouse** was the site of a 27<sup>th</sup> District Court Docket Call on March 24th. Presiding over the Court was 27<sup>th</sup> District Court Judge John Gauntt. Altogether 56 cases were brought to the court with 48 cases involving men and 8 cases involving women. Richard Hernandez of San Antonio failed to appear on the charge of aggravated assault with a deadly weapon. Damion Altimirano of Killeen failed to appear on the charge of evading arrest with a vehicle.

There were 17 cases involving possession of a controlled substance/PG1. There were 9 cases for possession less than a gram, 5 cases for possession of 1-4 grams, 2 cases for possession of 4-200 grams and one case of manufacture/delivery less than a gram in a drug free zone. There were 2 DWI cases.

There were 5 burglary cases, 4 cases for evading arrest, 3 cases of criminal mischief, and 2 cases of theft from person. There was

1 case each for theft of a firearm, bail jumping/FTA and prohibited substance in a correctional facility.

In crimes involving personal harm, there were 2 cases each for injury to a child/elderly/disabled person and assault on a family/household member. There was 1 case each for aggravated assault with a deadly weapon, and assaulting a public servant.

In other cases there were 5 cases of possession w/intent to promote child pornography. There were 2 cases each for continuous sexual abuse of a child under 14 years of age, aggravated sexual assault of a child and indecency with a child/sexual contact. There was 1 case each for sexual assault of a child, failure to register as a sex offender, and invasive visual recording.

Of the 56 cases, 5 were settled with Adam Trejo of Lometa pleading guilty to failure to comply with registering as a sex offender. Mr. Trejo was sentenced to 5 years TDCJ with all 5 years probated plus court costs and a \$1000 fine. Thomas Floyd plead guilty to possession of a controlled substance PG 1 less than a gram and was sentenced to 3 years probation plus court costs. Deedee Gilstrap on the charge of possession of a controlled substance PG 1 less than a gram saw her probation extended. Christopher Beamon of Moultrie, Georgia plead guilty and was found guilty on 2 charges of theft from person. Mr. Beamon was sentenced to 5 years TDCJ on each count with credit for days served toward sentence.

All other cases were reset or were set for jury trials.

## LCHEC College for Kids

The Lampasas County Higher Education Center is offering "College for Kids" again this summer.

So far they have announced the "Jr. Crime Scene Investigator/Jr. Police Academy: Case of the Missing Mascot". Kids will have the chance to ride in a police vehicle, learn about police equipment and see the daily tasks that law enforcement perform each day. Kids will then analyze handwriting and fingerprints, use dichotomous keys to identify plants and use a fiber flame test as they try to find out who took the school mascot before the big game! This course will take place on June 6th & 7th, from 9-11am, for ages 7-11. The cost is \$20. (cont'd on back)
