## The Weather

It was an odd weather day Sunday. Cool and cloudy, then sunny & windy, and most of it pretty uncomfortable.

**Today:** A chance of rain and sleet? Before 1pm, then a slight chance of sprinkles in the afternoon. Otherwise, it will be mostly cloudy, then gradually sunny with a high near 60°. The wind will be calm, then very light out of the N-NE. The rain chances are 30% overall.

**Tonight:** Clear, with a low around 40° and north wind very light, about 5 mph and turning calm.

**Tuesday:** Sunny and up to 72° with S-SW wind 5-10 mph. Overnight, it will be down to 49° with light wind.

**Rest of the week:** Wednesday will be cloudy again, with a 20% chance of rain and cloudy with a high near 71°. The wind will get up a bit with south wind 10-15 mph.

Thursday will bring a big change with a sunny day, taking the temperature up to 84° in the afternoon. The south wind will be brisk, 10-15 mph and gusting. It will shift to northerly in the evening, but on Friday it will go back to E-SE. The high will get up to 83° Friday. Overnight, some rain chances come in at 30% and that gets up to 60% on Saturday as we head into the weekend.
