Kempner Water Supply and Stage 3 Water Restrictions

As a follow-up to a memo sent to Kempner Water members dated March 15th, Kempner Water Supply released the following statement on March 31, 2023:

"We have been getting phone calls regarding the Stage 3 Conservation letter mailed to all members. We would like to take this opportunity to clarify some of those items.

KWSC will not be requiring you to not use water at any time. We are simply requesting that you refrain from watering your lawn, washing your car, filling your pool, etc...except on Tuesdays or Thursdays based on your address. Even number addresses on Thursday, odd numbers on Tuesdays.

Regular household use will not create an issue and will only cost you extra if you go over 7,000 gallons in one month. A residence uses about 4,000-5,000 gallons per month.

The lake levels are incredibly low and dropping every day. If we don't implement conservation tactics, we will eventually run out of water.

Because the lake is so low, our plant is pulling more and more sediment from the water. This creates problems within our filters and drastically slows our ability to treat the water quickly.

KWSC understand that your livestock NEEDS water, that is not considered excessive use.
