The Weather

The High yesterday 75° The Low this morning 57°

Today the forecasters say look for a few showers to develop across parts of Central Texas, which may move to the east along I-35. Later tonight, any rain should move eastward. A cold front will move into our area after daybreak tomorrow. The National Weather Service says that while severe storms could form, the main issue is the unusual wet start to the year. With the possibility of days of rain, Central Texas could exceed normal April rainfall in the first week of the month, and localized flooding could become a problem. Behind the cold front, unseasonably cool air will move into the region Friday night, with most of us in the 40's. All things appear to be in place for an overrunning pattern, bringing rain and storms for much of the day Saturday. Sunday will be warmer with continuing rain chances.

Today: Cloudy with a high near 73° and a 50% chance of showers and storms. The wind will be S-SE at 10-15 mph.

Tonight: A 30% chance of showers and storms this evening, then drizzle early tomorrow morning with a slight chance of storms. Look for a low near 65° and a S-SE wind at 10-15 mph.

Friday: Patchy fog in the morning, then cloudy skies with a high near 74° and a S wind at 5-10 mph, shifting NE in the afternoon. There is a slight chance of showers and storms in the morning, increasing through the afternoon. The chance of rain is 80%.

Friday Night: There is an 80% chance of showers and storms with some storms possibly becoming severe. Winds will be N-NE near 10 mph and a low of 52° .

Saturday: Cloudy skies and a high temperature near 58°. Winds will be N-NE near 10 mph. There is a 70% chance of precipitation.

Saturday Night: 57° with cloudy skies, and light N-NE wind shifting E in the evening. There is a 40% chance of showers and storms.

Sunday: A high temperature near 74° with wind becoming E-SE near 5 mph in the afternoon. Showers likely with a storm possible, the chance of precipitation is 60%.

Unconfirmed report of COVID 19 in Lampasas County Resident

According to an article in the Killeen Daily Herald, Coryell Health, Gatesville's hospital, announced Wednesday that it had received its first positive case of COVID-19.

Coryell Emergency Management Coordinator Robert Harrell stated the person was from Lampasas County.

Lampasas Radio spoke to County Judge Randall Hoyer, and he emphatically stated that they have no confirmation of this. Confirmation to the County Judge comes from the Region 7 Public Health Office, and at this time, no confirmation has been received.

Lampasas Radio also reached out to Dr. Georgia Hay, Lampasas County Public Health Authority who did confirm that while there was a positive case reported, it has not been confirmed that the person was a resident of Lampasas County. Lampasas Radio also reached out to Robert Harrell, Coryell County Emergency Management Coordinator and left a message. Lampasas Radio also called Coryell Health in Gatesville, and while they confirmed a positive test for the virus, they cannot say where the patient resided.

It appears that until a confirmation is received, this is all speculation.
