Rabies in Lampasas



Lampasas Radio received this press release from the Lampasas Police Dept.: "On the morning of March 30th, 2021, City of Lampasas Animal Control Officer Joe Schwartzter picked up an apparently ill skunk that had been trapped in a yard at a house in the 500 block of South Main in the City of Lampasas. Two dogs at the home had contact with the skunk. Officer Schwartzter euthanized the skunk and it was submitted to a lab for rabies testing. On April 1st, Schwartzter was notified the skunk tested positive for rabies. The dogs were current on their rabies vaccinations, but have received booster shots as a precaution." If you have animals, please check the status of their Rabies Vaccinations, and make sure they are current.

Dr. Georgia Hay shared with Lampasas Radio this morning that Lampasas was at 9 active cases, and 2105 total cases. There are 2 Lampasans in the hospital, and the county has seen 30 fatalities. The State of Texas saw 2,409 new confirmed cases yesterday, and 797 probable cases. 2,954 Texans are hospitalized with Covid-19

Badger Baseball gave in to Gatesville last night in their 3rd meeting of the season. **It was, as we're getting used to, a one run margin, 8-7.** Lampasas won the first game against the Hornets, 1-0. In their second meeting Lampasas won again, 5-0, but the run played out for the Badgers last night when the Hornets' came out hitting.

They got one run in the first inning, but gave up the lead in the second when the Badger bats started cracking away. Hayden Waldrip singled on a line drive to left field, Keagan Richardson singled to center and Eli Stanley sent a line drive to left again. Eli's singled brought in Waldrip and Richardson went to second. Ace Whitehead came to bat and sent a hit to right field that brought in Richardson to put the Badgers out front 2-1.

That lead held until the top of the 5th when the Hornets came back with another couple of runs. Gauge Gholson had been struggling on the mound to this point. He gave up a hit, a couple of walks and another hit that brought in a run, then hit a batter with a bad pitch. The obviously tiring pitcher was relieved by Carson Bekker. Lampasas came back in the bottom of the 5th on a double by Whitehead and sacrifice by Nate Borchardt that brought in Eli Stanley. Tak Stinnett got a ground ball error trip to 1st and Whitehead went home to make it 4-3 Lampasas.

In the top of the 6th, with Bekker still on the mound, Gatesville scored again. While Gatesville's top hurler had been on the mound and performing well all night, Lampasas was having a hard time finding the strike zone without Hornet batters sending the ball to the outfield. At the end of 6 innings it was Gatesville ahead 5-4. In the top of the 7th the Hornets rallied again, and scored 3 more runs. Coach Evans relieved Bekker, sending Nate Borchardt to the mound. The Badgers got out of the Hornet bat with a Gatesville lead of 8-4.

Just one more at-bat to change anything! Hopes were sinking fast. Logan Coleman was up first and singled, then Gholson popped out to the infield. Tak Stinnett singled and it was two on, then Dax Brookreson struck out – two outs but two on. Hayden Waldrip came to bat and, with his big round-house swing, sent one over the fence. To the crowd's delight it was now 8-7. Hope springs as Keagan Richardson came to bat, but it wasn't to be as the Hornet pitcher that had started the game, finished it with a swing and a miss and a strike three -game over – Gatesville wins 8-7.

The Badgers host Brownwood next Tuesday.
