(cont' d from front) accompanying piece of legislation, Senate Bill 9, which would give pay raises to teachers and increase funding for classrooms, among other measures. The bill will also go to the Senate floor for a vote.

The legislation would give parents who opt out of the public school system access to a savings account with up to \$8,000 in taxpayer money, per student, which could be used to pay for a child's private schooling and other educational expenses, such as textbooks or tutoring.

Historically, rural Republicans have opposed programs similar to vouchers because they fear they could take away money from their local school districts, which are often large employers with fragile budgets. SB 8, however, seeks to address those concerns by

shielding school districts with fewer than 20,000 students from any funding losses caused by the savings account program.

Those smaller districts would receive \$10,000 for two years for every student who enrolls in the savings account program and leaves their district.

SB 8 is likely to get approval from the full Senate, but it is not yet clear if the added funding for smaller districts will be enough to get the legislation through the House, which has been traditionally more skeptical of similar programs.
