The Weather

High yesterday was 67° The low this morning was 62°

Today: A few light showers early this morning, then clouds that gradually clear with the south wind of 5-15 mph becoming west in the afternoon. The high should get up to about 85°.

Tonight: Mostly clear with a low around 59° and N-NE wind 5-10 mph.

Friday: Partly sunny with a high near 85° and the 10 mph N-NE wind shifts to SE in the afternoon.

Overnight, the clouds come in after 2am and bring a 60% chance of rain. The low should be about 61°.

The Weekend: Saturday, festival day downtown Lampasas, is threatened with an 80% chance of rain. The south wind should be only about 10 mph (outside of any thunderstorm activity), and the high temperature should be a nice 78°. The rain chances continue into the early part of Saturday night.

The low Sunday morning should be about 68°, with only a small chance of early morning rain, then sunshine comes and the high may be about 80°.

Monday will be nice, with a high around 81°. It could be even warmer on Tuesday.

The "State" of Texas

You probably saw in the news recently that the execution of a prisoner was halted by the U.S. Supreme Court because Texas wouldn't allow a Buddhist chaplain into the death chamber. It seems Texas only allowed Christian and Muslim clerics because they were all the State had on their payroll.

The Supreme Court, via a Justice Brett Kavanaugh opinion, said Texas could either allow a chaplain of any religion in the death chamber, or they could just not allow any chaplains or clerics to be present. Texas says that from now on no chaplains would be able to be present in the death chamber.

On another front, the Texas legislature is still deciding on how to handle the school funding/property tax relief legislation. The Senate came in wanting a \$5,000 pay raise for all teachers and librarians. The House wanted to provide more cash funding to schools, and

allow the school districts to figure out how it could best be used in their district. Many of the schools had indicated they might want to use a merit system to give out pay raises.

It seems the House has now passed a bill that gets a little closer to the Senate idea. They have agreed to rules that would require mandatory pay raises of at least \$1,850 for teachers. That House Bill will now go to the Senate for consideration and the negotiations can begin.
