The Weather

High yesterday was 86° The low this morning was 58°

Today: Partly sunny, with a high near 82° this afternoon. The wind will move from NE to E-SE at 5-10 mph.

Tonight: A 40% chance of showers and thunderstorms after 2am, otherwise cloudy with a low around 65° .

Saturday: There is an 80% chance of rain, mostly from 8am to 2pm, some storms could be severe. There should be a high of around 76° . The southerly wind is expected to be typically 5-10 mph, outside of possible storms.

Saturday night the rain chance is 50%, with a low around 71° . Thunderstorms are possible.

Sunday morning rain is possible, but that should go away and the afternoon temp will rise to the low 80s. Light wind about 5-10 mph will come from the SW.

Monday and Tuesday appear to bring nice weather and the afternoon temperatures will get higher each day, peaking around 90° on Wednesday, then getting cooler in the latter part of the week.

Cove to Elect Mayor Apr. 27th

A special situation brings about a Special Election on April 27th to elect a new Mayor in Copperas Cove.



The Mayor of Copperas Cove, Frank Seffrood, had died in late December. In his absence, the Mayor Pro-tem, Dan Yancy has been filling the seat, pending election of a new Mayor. The regular Election Day for City Council seats in Texas is May 4th, however, that won't work for Copperas Cove. The City Charter says when such a vacancy comes up for the Mayor's seat, an Election must be held within 120 days. That winds up requiring an Apr. 27 Special Election.

Running for the seat are two men and two women.

They are: Ron Nelson, Bradi Diaz, Joey Acfalle and Brandi Weland.

Early Voting begins next Wednesday, April 10 at the polling place at 210 South 1st in Copperas Cove.
