The Weather



The high yesterday 85° This morning's low 55°

The airport received .36 inches of rain this morning.

Today: Look for mostly cloudy skies and a high temperature near 74° with a 40% chance of showers through late morning. N wind at 15-20 mph with gusts as high as 30 mph.

Tonight: Look for mostly cloudy skies and the low temperature will dip to near 48° and a slight chance of showers early tomorrow morning. Wind will be N-NE at 10-15 mph gusting to 20 mph.

Thursday: Mostly cloudy skies with a high temperature near 59° and a 70% chance of precipitation. Wind will be NE near 15 mph with possible gusts of 25 mph.

Thursday Night: Cloudy skies with a low near 48° and a 60% chance of showers and storms. The wind will be from the NE near 15 mph and possible gusts of 25 mph.

Friday: Skies will be cloudy with a high temperature near 58° and a 60% chance of showers and storms. Breezy N-NE winds will be near 15 mph with possible gusts of 25 mph.

Friday Night: Mostly cloudy skies and the low will be near 49°. Wind will be N-NE near 10-15 mph with gusts as high as 20 mph. There is a 30% chance of precipitation.

Mr. Witcher and the Fire Chief also spoke about being fire aware and to be extremely careful burning over the next week or so, as the gusty north winds drop the relative humidity (which makes things burn quicker), and with the fuel on the ground at this time, a controlled burn can get out of hand very quickly.

Lampasas ISD School Bus in Minor Accident Last Week

On Friday March 31st, Texas DPS Troopers responded at 6:56am to a report of a minor crash involving two passenger cars and a school bus on FM 2808 in Kempner.

"A 2005 Mini Cooper, operated by a 22-year-old male from Kempner, TX, was stopped facing westbound in the lane of travel. The Mini Cooper was stopped waiting to turn south into a private drive and was waiting for an approaching school bus to pass. A 2011 Honda Odyssey van, operated by a 29-year-old female from Kempner, TX, was approaching the Mini Cooper from behind. The driver of the Honda failed to control speed and struck the rear of the Mini Cooper. The collision caused the Mini Cooper to go into the eastbound lane and struck the left side of the school bus. The school bus was occupied by the 59-year-old driver, three child passengers, ages, 5, 9, and 11. The driver of the Mini Cooper sustained a non-incapacitating injury and was treated on scene. The driver of the Honda, and the two passengers, ages 10 and 3, all sustained a non-incapacitating injury. One occupant in the school bus was treated on scene for a non-incapacitating injury.
