The Weather

Look for warmer and more humid weather today. Light showers continue to develop across our area ahead of a small system. The activity will continue to move east. We may see a shower or storm this afternoon.

Today: Cloudy with a high near 76°. Wind will be S at 5-10 mph, and there is a 20% chance of rain. Storms are possible after 2pm.

Tonight: There is a 20% chance of showers in the evening, with cloudy skies overnight. The winds will be S-SE at 5-10 mph. The low temperature will be near 66°.

Tuesday: Mostly cloudy skies and a high temperature near 86°. Winds will be SW at 5-10 mph. There is a 20% chance of showers and storms in the afternoon.

Tuesday Night: Mostly cloudy with a low temperature near 67°. Winds will be light out of the S-SW becoming calm in the evening. There is a 20% chance of showers before 8pm.

Copperas Cove Renews Disaster Declaration

The Copperas Cove City Council unanimously approved City Ordinance 2020-22 extending a declaration of local disaster; establishing rules and regulations for the duration of disaster; restricting certain activities; establishing penalties for violations.

The city ordinance concurs with an executive order that was issued on March 31, 2020 by Texas Governor Greg Abbott, Executive Order GA-14.

The City continues to monitor information on Coronavirus (COVID-19) that is being disseminated from various agencies to include National, State and Local. The City Leadership team comprised of Mayor Bradi Diaz, Department Directors and Emergency Management continue to monitor and exchange information relevant to this situation and the well-being of our community.

At this time, city staff will continue to provide essential services to the citizens and will only make modifications to those services as needed or mandated to ensure the greatest safety to the citizens and city staff.

Lometa ISD sent out the following update:

April 1, 2020

Update - Important Scheduling Information:

The purpose of this letter is to inform students and parents that Lometa School will extend the "Work from Home Period" **through May 4th** in accordance with new social distancing timelines provided by Governor Greg Abbott. With this in mind, we will continue the Monday and Thursday instructional folder exchange/weekly breakfast/lunch provisions **with the following exceptions :**

Friday, April 10

(previously scheduled holiday) and the week of April 13-17

(After Easter Sunday) will be a no-school

period. This no-school period will allow a time of intensive social distancing and an opportunity for

students and staff to recharge before beginning anew on

Monday, April 20.

During the April 10 – 17 break window, there will be no new instruction and no breakfast or lunch will be provided. Students who are behind, may be asked to continue makeup work during this break.

Timeline Information:

● **Friday, April 3rd**

○ End of 5th 6 Weeks. All work due **Monday, April 6th.**

● **Monday - Thursday, April 6 - 9**

○ Regular Work from Home Instruction/Breakfast and Lunch available. Because Friday,

April 10, is a holiday, there will be no new instruction on Thursday, April 9. **Turn in any work that is finished. Students may receive catch-up work only.**

● **Friday - April 10**

○ Previously scheduled School Holiday (Good Friday). No new instruction and no breakfast or lunch available.

● **Monday - Friday, April 13-17 - School Break, Intensive social distancing.**

○ No new instruction.

○ No breakfast or lunch.

● **Monday - Friday, April 20 - 24 and April 27 - May 1**

○ Regular Work from Home Instruction/Breakfast and Lunch available.

This timeline subject to change as conditions evolve. Lometa ISD officials will continue to monitor information as it becomes available and provide timely updates.
