**Today:** Today is expected to be cloudy with a high temperature near 84°, and winds will be S- at 15-20 mph with possible gusts of 30 mph.

**Tonight:** Skies will be mostly cloudy with a low near 64°, and the S winds will continue at 15-20 mph gusting to 30 mph.

**Wednesday:** Mostly cloudy with gradual clearing and a high temperature near 82°. Winds will be S-SW shifting N in the afternoon at 10-15 mph with possible gusts of 25 mph or more.

**Overnight Wednesday:** Mostly clear skies with a low near 56°, and winds becoming light from the S-SE after midnight.

## Governor Abbott Prohibits State Agencies from Requiring Vaccine or Services

Governor Greg Abbott today issued an Executive Order prohibiting state agencies or political subdivisions in Texas from creating a "vaccine passport" requirement, or otherwise conditioning receipt of services on an individual's COVID-19 vaccination status. The order also prohibits organizations receiving public funds from requiring consumers to provide documentation of vaccine status in order to receive any service or enter any place.

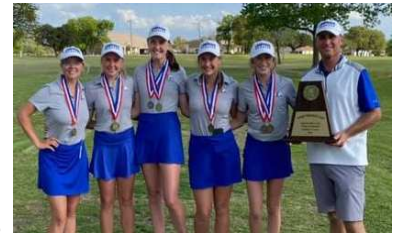
"Everyday, Texans are returning to normal life as more people get the safe and effective COVID-19 vaccine. But, as I've said all along, these vaccines are always voluntary and never forced," said Governor Abbott. "Government should not require any Texan to

show proof of vaccination and reveal private health information just to go about their daily lives. That is why I have issued an Executive Order that prohibits government-mandated vaccine passports in Texas. We will continue to vaccinate more Texans and protect public health — and we will do so without treading on Texans' personal freedoms."

This comes as vaccine credentials, often referred to as vaccine passports, are being developed around the world as a way to quickly prove someone's vaccination status, particularly with private companies. Businesses can require their employees to get a COVID-19 vaccine, according to guidance from the Equal Employment Opportunity Commission.

Governor Abbott has also extended the Covid-19 Disaster Declaration.


