Meetings Monday

The Lampasas County Commissioners Court will meet on Monday at 9am for a regular session. The agenda includes an Award Bid for Gas & diesel for the County, how and where to dispose of excess construction material from the jail project. A donation of land will be discussed, a 3.24 acre tract on CR 2699, and a change of contract for court collection services, as well as the burn ban and of course, the jail project.

Lampasas County Commissioners will then have a called meeting at 1:30 pm. On the agenda for that meeting is discussion of a department head and a vacant house on the jail site property.

Lampasas City Council will meet in a workshop session at 5:30pm to discuss Code Enforcement Efforts, Food Truck Ordinance and Music Venues, and also the city of Lampasas Comprehensive Plan.

In the regular session there will be a presentation about National Public Safety Telecommunications Week, a public hearing regarding ordinance for sex offenders. Then some routine matters, and in new business, possible action regarding the sex offender ordinance, approval of a the Hillside Acres plat, the upcoming election, the Special Local Option Election, and issues regarding security cameras for the Old City Hall.
