## The Weather

Rainfall on Thursday was .06 inches, and on Wednesday it was .36 inches so it looks like the last few days have brought us about .42 to half an inch in some spots around the county. But, there should be more today.

**Today's Good Friday forecast:** The chances of rain appear to be 90% today, decreasing some overnight, but the temperature is predicted to hit the mid-50s today. There should be some N-NE wind today, 10-15 mph, and that will lessen tonight and Saturday.

**Tonight:** The clouds will be predominant again with rain chances at 60%. It will not be quite as windy but still coming out of the NE.

**Saturday:** It will be mostly cloudy but warmer, with the high getting up to the upper 60s and the wind still northerly but fairly light. There is still a 20% chance of a shower.

**Easter Sunday:** It will be cloudy but getting up to about 70° and the wind will be coming out of the east for the most part – but very light. It will be a pleasant enough day for an Easter Egg Hunt.

## Lampasas ISD Pre-K and Kindergarten Round-Up

**Lampasas ISD** will hold their Kindergarten Round-Up on April 19<sup>th</sup> from 8am to 6pm at Hanna Springs, Kline Whitis, and Taylor Creek Elementary schools.

Children that turn 5 on or before September 1<sup>st</sup> can be registered for Kindergarten. Children that turn 4 on or before September 1<sup>st</sup> can register for Pre-K. Pre-K students must qualify for enrollment based on state guidelines.

Legal Guardians should bring a copy of an immunization (shot) record, birth certificate, social security card, a proof of residence (usually a utility bill) and a photo ID of the person enrolling the child.

## Talk, Text, Crash

Distracted driving is on the rise in Texas, and TxDOT is urging all Texans to pay attention on the road.



In an instant, Karin Zaltsman lost her teenaged daughter when a driver made the decision to take their eyes off the road to text while driving. In recognition of National Distracted Driving Awareness Month, TxDOT is sharing the Zaltsman's story of losing 13-year-old Emily, to remind Texans to keep their eyes up and phones down while driving. Described as kind, funny, smart, and driven, Emily had her whole life ahead of her, but one driver's decision to text and drive cut her life short.

"Emily didn't die in an accident," said Karin Zaltsman of her late daughter. "Emily died in a crash that could have been prevented."

Disturbingly, distracted driving deaths increased by 10% in 2022. Approximately one of every six crashes on Texas roadways last year was attributed to distracted driving. (*cont'd on back*)

## The Blotter



**The Lampasas Police Dept. Blotter** for Thursday showed an assault report at 11:08am in the 2700 block of 281S. There was a minor accident in the 500 block of S. Willis St. and another one in the 6600 block of 183N at 2:46pm. Just a minute later the dispatcher was taking a theft report from the 700 block of Brown St. At 3pm there was another accident, this one in the 800 block of N. Key Ave. There were no arrests for police but there is a lot of traffic on Key Ave...That should bring a lot of activity for local cops.

**The Lampasas County Sheriff's Dept.** for Thursday shows Lometa with livestock issues. In Kempner there were reports of suspicious activity and civil matters. Out in the county there were suicidal persons, mental health calls, medical calls, accidents, reports of suspicious activity and a warrant was served. Deputies went into Cove on livestock issues.

**The Jail Log** shows the arrest of 46 year old Lanita Antolik of Lampasas for DWI/open container and duty on striking/highway landscape. Also arrested was Karen McDonald, 61, of Lampasas on an out-of-county charge. 36 year old Austin Schaar of DeWitt Michigan was brought in for assaulting a public servant, and a 52 year old Pflugerville man was booked in on a commitment charge.

*(cont'd from front)* Texting while driving is not only incredibly dangerous, it's a crime. Since Sept. 1, 2017, it has been illegal to read, write or send a text while driving in Texas, and violators can face a fine of up to \$200.

Distracted driving crashes are 100% preventable. TxDOT offers these tips to help drivers steer clear of a potentially deadly situation: (1) Always give driving your full attention—any distraction is dangerous. (2) Put your phone away, turn it off or use an app or phone settings to block texts and calls while driving. (3) Pull off the road entirely and come to a complete stop before you use your phone. (4) Tell friends, family, and coworkers you won't respond to texts or calls while driving.

## Copperas Cove Stage 1 Water Restrictions

The City of Copperas Cove would like to remind all water users, to include residents, businesses and other entities, that the previously issued Stage 1 Water Restrictions ordered on August 8, 2022 remain in effect due to current lake levels. Updates will be shared with local media, as well as posted on the City's website at [www.copperascovetx.gov](http://www.copperascovetx.gov) and various social media pages

(2) Stage 1 response—Moderate water shortage conditions

a. Goal. To raise citizen and customer awareness regarding water demand and potential drought conditions and to encourage voluntary water conservation by reducing unnecessary water use. Achieve a 5-10% reduction in daily water demand.

b. Supply management measures. The City of Copperas Cove will reduce flushing of water mains, reduce irrigation of public landscaped areas; use of reclaimed water for nonpotable purposes will be allowed

Water use recommendations. Some guidelines for conservation are: (1) Irrigation of landscaped areas with hose-end sprinklers or automatic irrigation systems should be limited to any two (2) days of the week between the hours of midnight and 10am, and from 8pm until midnight.

(2) Outdoor water use should be limited between the hours of 10am and 8pm, except when a hand-held hose, a faucet-filled bucket, or a watering can of 5 gallons or less is used.
