The Weather



The High yesterday 87° The Low this morning 71° The main weather story for today is the above normal temperatures. Some places may break the record high temperatures. While there is a slight risk of severe weather today, it is highly conditional on where it develops. We will see a cold front move through the area tomorrow, probably early in the day. **Today**: Partly sunny, with a high temperature near 90° and a W wind at 5-10 mph.

Tonight: Mostly cloudy skies with a low near 63°, and a NW wind at 5-10 mph shifting S-SE. there is a 20% chance of showers and thunderstorms this evening.

Thursday: Cloudy with a high near 77° and a slight chance of showers in the morning, increasing in the afternoon. There is a 50% chance of showers and storms. The wind will be light out of the north.

Thursday Night: A low near 56° and a slight chance of showers and storms (20%). The skies will be mostly cloudy. Wind will be light out of the N becoming calm.

Friday: Mostly cloudy with a high temperature near 70° and a 40% chance of showers and storms in the afternoon. The wind will be E-SE at 5-10 mph.

Friday Night: Mostly cloudy with a low near 59° and a 50 chance of showers and storms. The wind will be SE near 5 mph.

To his knowledge, Mr. de Graffenreid stated that there have been approximately 80 tests in Lampasas County. The 2 positive tests were given in Coryell County.



The Burn Ban has been lifted indefinitely

Locally, Bell County has 68 cases, 2 deaths; Williamson County 81 cases, 3 deaths; , Llano County 3 cases, Burnet County 5 cases, Hamilton County has 1 case, and Lampasas County has 2 cases.
