Commissioners Court

The **Lampasas County Commissioners Court** will meet Monday April 10th at 9am in the Commissioners Courtroom in the Lampasas County Courthouse.

The Agenda includes the consent agenda, accounts payable and payroll, discussion of the TxDOT US281 Relief Route, awarding gas 7 diesel at station bid, a request for bids for no spec/spec flex base and approving new members to the Lampasas County Historical Commission.

City Council to Meet

The **Lampasas City Council** will meet Monday April 10th for regularly scheduled meetings.

The Workshop Session will begin at 5:30pm and the agenda includes discussion about the Solar Eclipse Town Hall Meeting and discussion regarding Department Certification Pay.

The Regular Session will begin immediately following the Workshop Session (possibly prior to 6pm), and will see the swearing in ceremony of Officer Jason Leamons by Judge Gradel. This will be followed by public hearings on amending the city code for industrial sewer use, and amending the Employee Personnel Policy with the departmental certification pay as it relates to specific job responsibilities. The Agenda also includes the Consent Agenda to include discussion and possible action regarding an ordinance amending Chapter 54, Parks and Recreation, Sulphur Creek and Division 3 Parks of the Lampasas Code of Ordinances, and re-adopting the curfew for minors as required by state law every 3 years. The City Manager's Operational Report will cover the pool season, utility rates, the skate park, the 580 sports park, the senior center and the EMS report.

New business will include the presentation and acceptance of the Emergency Management Report and discussion an possible action on the following: the ratification of purchase for a 2023 Chevrolet 1500 crew cab for the cemetery in the amount of \$38,179.86, the amendment to Chapter 82 (*cont'd on back*)

Combating the Fentanyl Crisis in Texas

Governor Greg Abbott this week announced two major statewide initiatives to combat the growing national fentanyl crisis and save innocent lives in Texas during his One Pill Kills Summit in Austin. During a press conference following panel discussions, the Governor unveiled a new \$10 million multimedia awareness initiative through the Texas Health and Human Services Commission (HHSC) to educate Texans on how to prevent, recognize, and reverse fentanyl poisonings as part of the statewide "One Pill Kills" campaign. The Governor also announced the plan to distribute Naloxone (NARCAN) to all 254 Texas counties by the Texas Division of Emergency Management (TDEM).

Fentanyl, a synthetic opioid, is the leading killer of Americans between the ages of 18-45. Last year, more than 2,000 lives were lost to fentanyl in Texas. According to provisional data from the Texas Department of State Health Services, Texas has experienced a 500% increase in fentanyl-related deaths since 2019. Under Operation Lone Star, Texas law enforcement alone has seized over 380 million lethal doses of fentanyl since 2021—enough to kill every man, woman, and child in America.

The announcement of statewide distribution of NARCAN, a nasal medication that rapidly reverses opioid poisonings, comes after several opioid manufacturers entered into a legal settlement with the State of Texas, thanks to the efforts by the Office of the Attorney General of Texas. A portion of the settlement allocates NARCAN to the State of Texas to support communities in fighting the opioid crisis. TDEM will circulate the allotments of NARCAN and will soon begin distributing the first 20,000 units to county sheriffs' offices across the state. Each of Texas' 254 county sheriff's offices will be eligible to receive a portion of this first allotment based on county population and size. TDEM is notifying all 254 sheriffs of the upcoming distribution, and each may request that county's initial allotment through the State of Texas Assistance Request (STAR) process.
