Lampasas City Council met on Monday evening and discussed code enforcement efforts, a food truck ordinance, and added an article to chapter 50 of city ordinances. It now states that sex offenders may not reside within 1000ft of places where children gather and/or 300ft from a city park.

Lampasas Sheriff's Dept. blotter shows Lometa responded to a civil matter. Kempner was dispatched to a wreck, went out on a reported threat, worked a theft case and had a few civil matters. Out in the county deputies were sent out on a disturbance, served a warrant, and responded to accidents.

It seems there is over 15 dump truck loads of "block CMU" or cinder blocks left over from the construction of the new jail. Some were advised it would be put on the land south of the new jail, while others questioned if it could be used at a later date. It seems the county was looking for a disposal site for this material, but decided the table the issue for now.
