The Weather



The High yesterday 90° The Low this morning 72°

The forecasters say that where today's cold front stalls out will have the potential for severe weather. This is expected to be in the Central Texas area. If the storms form, they have the possibility for hail and strong winds. If the front stalls to the north, we will be seeing the storms, if it pushes through to the coast, we will see little or no rain.

Today: Cloudy with a high near 79° and a 60% chance of showers and storms this afternoon increasing into this evening. The wind will be W at 5 mph.

Tonight: A 70% chance of showers and storms this evening mostly before 8pm. look for a low near 55° and a N wind at 5-15 mph.

Friday: Partly sunny skies with a high near 71° and a N-NE wind at 10-15 mph, shifting E in the afternoon.

Friday Night: There is a 40% chance of showers and storms after 8pm. Skies will be mostly cloudy, winds will be light E-SE and the low will be near 58°.

Saturday: Cloudy skies and a 80% chance of showers and storms with a high temperature near 73°. Winds will be S-SE near 5 mph.

Saturday Night: 57° with cloudy skies, and light S wind becoming calm. There is an 80% chance of showers and storms after 8pm

Dr. Chane Rascoe, Joey McQueen, principal of Lampasas High School, and David Millican, President of the LISD School Board visited the Lampasas Radio Studios today.

There is no decision on when to go back to school yet. Dr. Rascoe stated he speaks to the Education Commissioner twice a week and will let us know as soon as there is word.

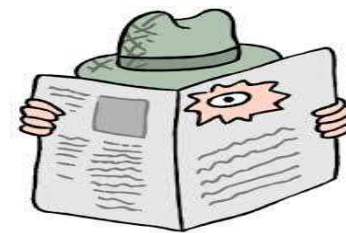

Coronavirus by the Numbers

According to the latest numbers from DSHS, Texas has 9,353 confirmed cases with 177 deaths. 96,258 Texans have been tested, and 770 people are recovered.

Unemployment Numbers in Texas

Here's how many Texans filed for unemployment relief

According to the Texas Tribune, More than 760,000 Texans have applied for unemployment insurance over the last four weeks, exceeding the roughly 700,000 people who filed for unemployment relief in Texas in all of 2019.

Just last week, a historic 313,832 Texans submitted unemployment insurance claims, which was a 13.6% jump from the previous week's short-lived record. Analysts expect many more people to lose work in the coming weeks as more than 1 million Texans are expected to be jobless.

The numbers are early — but incomplete — indicators of how dramatically and suddenly the state's economy collapsed under social distancing orders officials issued to curb the still growing public health crisis spurred by the novel coronavirus. And the numbers already available don't include massive amounts of out-of-work Texans who have struggled in vain to file unemployment claims because they can't get through to the Texas Workforce Commission, which has been inundated by people seeking aid. Of the 3.5 million calls the agency received Tuesday, 3.1 million calls were met with a busy signal, said Cisco Gamez, a spokesperson for the commission.

The Texas Tribune is tracking the number of out-of-work Texans filing for unemployment relief with the Texas Workforce Commission each week since the coronavirus pandemic began.

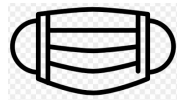
The week ending April 4, **313,832** Texans filed new applications for unemployment relief. From March 15 to April 4, a total of **744,855** Texans filed new claims. More likely attempted to file, but were deterred by an overwhelmed website and phone lines.
