Coronavirus Update



Dr. Georgia Hay shared with Lampasas Radio this morning that Lampasas was at 18 active cases, and 2125 total cases. There are 2 Lampasans in the hospital, and the county has seen 30 fatalities.

The State of Texas saw 2,445 new confirmed cases yesterday, and 732 probable cases. 2,586 Texans are hospitalized with Covid-19. Dr. Hay shares that she has resigned effective May 31st, and will not have updates as frequent at this point. She is focusing her efforts on getting residents in our area vaccinated.

On that note, KVUE out of Austin reports that According to Imelda Garcia with the Department of State Health Services (DSHS) Expert Vaccine Allocation Panel, Texas will go from about 500,000 doses of the Johnson & Johnson vaccine this week to about 130,000 next week. That amounts to a decrease of about 74%. Garcia said she still expects a good allocation for next week, just not as high as it could be.

"We think it still should be close to about 2 million doses available in Texas for next week," she said. "With additional reductions looking ahead, I don't know yet what the true impact will be. We'll have to be much more strategic and much more laser-focused in where the limited J&J goes in order to make sure those who are most vulnerable and can't get to other vaccines easily will have access to the limited J&J that we have."
