Rabid Bat Reported in Copperas Cove

Copperas Cove Animal Control released a statement yesterday that last Wednesday a resident of Copperas Cove was bitten by a bat in the 400 block of Lutheran Church Rd. The resident was able to kill the bat, and went to the hospital and took the bat with them. When the person returned from the hospital, Copperas Cove Animal Control received the bat and it was sent to the

Texas Dept. of Health Laboratory in Austin. On April 7th, Copperas Cove Animal Control received notification that the bat was infected with rabies.

Anyone who thinks that they or their pet or anyone they know has had contact with a bat or any other wild animal in this area should immediately contact Copperas Cove animal control at (254)547-5584 and also contact their doctor and/or veterinarian.

Signs of rabies infection in a human may include but are not limited to fever, headaches, fatigue, trouble breathing, possible paralysis and/or coma. In pets the symptoms may include fever, chewing at the site of the infection or bite, erratic behavior, walking aimlessly, restlessness, aggression and generally unnatural behavior for that animal. Citizens are warned not to approach or have contact with wild animals, or to allow their pets to approach wild animals.

Anyone seeing a wild animal acting strangely should contact animal control immediately.
