The Weather



The High Yesterday: 85° **Low this morning:** 61°

Today will be a sunny day with a high around 89°. Light wind from the SSE will blow around 10 to 15mph. Winds could gust as high as 25mph.

Tonight: There will be some clear skies with a low around 62°. Wind will come from the south at 10 to 15mph, with gusts getting up to around 25mph.

Commissioners Court Agenda



The Lampasas County Commissioners Court is having a regular meeting on Monday, April 14th, at 9am in the Lampasas County Annex Building in the Conference Room.

They will discuss the approval on authorization for the payment for the Texas Association of Counties liability renewal coverage. A discussion over the precinct 4 contract to switch judicial/municipal court computer programs from incode 9 to LGS. **Brief discussion will be held on the Burn Ban.**

One big topic that will be in discussion is the opposition to the proposed construction and operation of a new rail line by Texas Materials, Inc.

Lampasas City Council will also have a meeting on Monday. There will be more discussion on the Railway and discussions on Presentations and Proclamations.

Water Conservation



The Stage 1 Response for mild water shortage conditions. Their target is to achieve a voluntary 5 percent reduction in total **water use or daily water demand.**

The best management practices for supply management would be for the city to manage limited water supplies and/or **reduce water demand by increased leak detection** and repair efforts. It will also be initiating public notification.

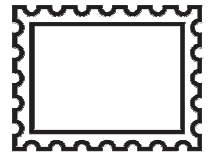
Voluntary Water Use Restrictions for Reducing Demand:

(a) **Water customers are requested** to voluntarily limit the irrigation of landscaped areas to **Mondays and Thursdays** for customers with a street address ending in an even number (0, 2, 4, 6 or 8), and **Tuesdays and Fridays** customers with a street address ending in an odd number (1, 3, 5, 7 or 9), and to irrigate landscapes only between the hours of 10:00 p.m. and 8:00 a.m. on designated watering days.

(b) All operations of the City shall adhere to water use restrictions prescribed for Stage 1 of the Plan.

(c) Water customers are requested to practice water conservation and to minimize or discontinue water use for non-essential purposes.

Stamp Prices



Sending mail is possibly going to get more expensive as soon as July. The US Postal Service proposed raising the cost of a stamp from **73 cents to 78 cents.** Metered mail, usually used by businesses, would increase from 69 cents to 74 cents. **Domestic postcards** would cost more as well — from 56 cents to 62 cents. Same goes for international mail — **increasing up to \$1.65.**

Texas 2 Year Budget Approved

The Texas House passed a two-year, approximately \$337 billion budget early Friday, allocating billions for teacher pay raises, border security, and property tax cuts. **The vote followed over 13 hours of debate** during which hundreds of proposed amendments from both Democrats and hardline conservatives were ultimately rejected.

Passed on a 118-26 vote, the House's proposal includes roughly \$154 billion in general revenue, the state's primary source of taxpayer dollars for essential services. **Most of that funding would go to education**, with substantial allocations also directed to health and human services and public safety.
