## The Weather



High yesterday was 74° The low this morning was 43°

**Today:** Sunny, with a high near 78° and SE wind 5-10 mph increasing to 10-15 mph this afternoon. The wind could gust to 20 mph.

**Tonight:** The rain chances for the overnight have decreased, now seen as 60% with rainfall amounts of less than 1/10 of an inch. The low should be about 59° and the wind out of the E-SE at 5-10 mph.

**Saturday:** The rainfall chance for the weekend start is up a bit, now seen as a 90% chance. The winds start at light and E-NE but shift to west and stronger in the afternoon. The high temp on Saturday should be about 70-71°.

Saturday night the cold front hits with a rain chance of about 40%, with a chilling low of around 43°. The wind will be NW about 20 mph and could gust to 30 mph

Sunday morning the rain ends but the NW wind is still around at 10-15 mph and gusting to 20 mph. The high should get back to about 69° and the cold front should get pushed out in the overnight, taking us back to spring weather on Monday. The Monday high should be about 80°

## Substitute Teacher Fired

In a release from Lampasas ISD Superintendent Chane Rascoe, he details that on April 4<sup>th</sup> school officials were notified of an accusation of inappropriate electronic and social media communication between a substitute teacher and a minor student. The school and the Lampasas P.D. began an investigation and the

school placed the substitute on leave pending the outcome. Though the investigation is still ongoing by police, the school district did determine that the substitute was in violation of school policy. As a result, that substitute teacher was terminated.

The Superintendent did note that all Lampasas ISD employees, including substitute teachers, are required to have background check, and this individual's background check had cleared prior to starting as a substitute.

## How're We Doin' \$\$\$ ?



Texas comptroller Glenn Hegar's office has sent checks to Texas Cities and Counties for their cut of the sales tax collected in their areas in February. The taxes were submitted by businesses in March and the checks cut in April. Overall in Central Texas, the returns were very impressive.

### Area Checks were:

- Lampasas - \$144,472 up 14.75% from April of 2018
- Kempner - \$7,845 up 14.26% from April of 2018
- Lometa - \$5,790 up 16.09% from April of 2018
- Burnet - \$212,151 up 40.42% from April of 2018
- San Saba - \$32,975 up 13.28% from April of 2018
- Goldthwaite - \$34,794 up 7.53% from April of 2018
- Copperas Cove - \$412,863 up 14.41% from April 2018
