The Weather



High yesterday was 74° The low this morning was 60°

Only .03 in rainfall at the airport by 10am, but west of town it was raining pretty hard at that time. The rain was pre-ceded by stiff east, then north winds.

Today: The rain is expected to come right up to 1pm, with the temperatures falling to the high 50s. The east wind will shift to W-NW at 15-20 mph with wind gusts to 30. We don't expect a lot of rainfall, just a noisy cold front coming through.

Tonight: The cold front bring a NW wind tonight of 20-25 mph that will gust to as much as 40 mph. Lock down your outdoor furniture and trash cans. The temperature should drop to about 42 overnight. Turn the heat back on!

Sunday: The morning will start for us in the low 40s and get up to a near normal 69° in the afternoon, though the front's wind will still be a bit bothersome out of the NW.

Monday will be back to sunny and near 80s in the afternoon and that looks like a norm until mid-week.

The Blotter



Lampasas Police Dept. blotter from Thursday shows a quiet night, then a minor accident in the 1300 block of W. Ave B. In the 2700 block of 281 S at 10:59 am, there was a harassment reported, then a theft at 11am. 11:51 am saw a suspicious person in the 200 block of N. Key.

The afternoon saw a theft in the 1200 block of W. 3rd at 2:44 pm, a suspicious vehicle reported in the 1200 block of W. Ave C at 2:57 pm, a harassment in the 300 block of Brook St. at 3:57 pm and a suspicious vehicle in the 1200 block of W. Ave C at 4:05 pm.

There were 2 arrests as a 19 year old Kempner woman was detained for possession of marijuana under 2 ounces, and a 20 year old Lampasas man was arrested for DWI at 11:25 pm.

Lampasas Sheriff's Dept. blotter shows Lometa was dispatched out on a theft and a livestock issue. Kempner responded to a disturbance. Out in the county, there were a few civil matters, a report of a stolen vehicle. Deputies were sent out to Cove on a disturbance call, responded to a theft case and a shots fired call.

The Jail Log shows the county had two arrests. A 37 years old Round Rock woman was taken into custody on a failure-to-appear charge, and another arrest was on a former Lampasas Police Officer who was arrested in a traffic stop in Kempner for producing a false ID as a police officer. The officer had worked for Lampasas PD for 8 months in 2018, and had resigned. This former officer still had police ID in his possession.

She attended high school in Weinert where she was a cheerleader, band member, 1941 homecoming queen, editor of the yearbook and later a teacher. Polly had a love of fashion and owned the Cinderella Dress Shops in Weinert and Rising Star. She continued her education at Hardin Simmons College and later graduated from North Texas State with a major in Home Economics and a double minor in Chemistry and Art. Her first job offer after graduation was as a buyer for Neiman Marcus.

During WWII, she worked at Consolidated Aircraft Co. (now Lockheed Martin) in Fort Worth and served her country as a Rosie the Riveter, installing the bomb bay side panels on the B-24 Liberator. Her contributions to the war effort are recognized at the National WWII Museum in New Orleans.

She drove thousands of miles following her daughters to band competitions and when the girls attended Howard Payne, she continued as a band booster and designed travel uniforms for the HPU band.

After George and Polly retired and moved to Copperas Cove, she joined 1st Baptist Church and continued to share her love of fashion by creating costumes for church and school musical productions.
