The High Yesterday: 91° **Low this morning:** 72°

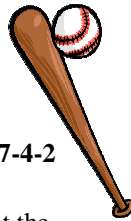
Today: It is going to be a sunny day with the high reaching around 93. SSW wind will breeze in at 5 to 15mph, with gusts as high as 25mph.

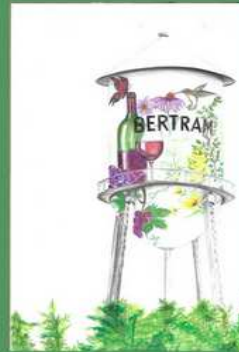


The annual round-up is a time for parents and legal guardians to register their school-aged children for the 2025-2026 school year. Students registering for Kindergarten must be turning 5 on/before September 1, 2024 and students registering for Pre-K must be turning 4 on/before that date.

You will need to bring a copy of your child's shot records, birth certificate, social security card, proof of residence (utility service in guardian's name or notarized affidavit) and a photo ID of the guardian enrolling the child. **And of course, please bring your child with you!**

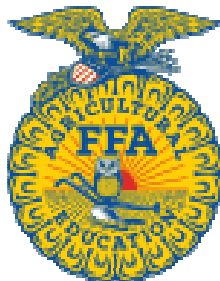
