City Council Synopsis

The City Council met last night at the Calvert

Municipal Building and some discussion was had on the proposed rail line and what the city’s position would be. **Councilman Pratus expressed some concern** that if the city mirrors the proposal made by the commissioners court in opposing the line that the city should be able to demonstrate concrete evidence to back up claims. **City Manager Erin Corbell reported** that the Wayfinding sign project will get underway on the 21st and that the city has received several applications for the part time airport position. The **Hostess House update stands at LOC** delivering the final structural engineering report to the council during the next meeting. The Brazos River Authority also announced Stage 1 drought conditions which include voluntary restrictions going into effect with the **hopes of declining daily usage by 5%**. The city also threw its support behind the Woolfstock Fundraising Event hosted by SAFE Lampasas & the Lampasas Animal Shelter **held at WM Brook Park on May 3rd.**

Commissioners Court

The Lampasas Commissioners Court met yesterday and several citizens began by expressing their desire to see the county fund "the HOP" operated by the Hill Country Transit District (HCTD). **Sheriff Parker notified the court** that the fundraising for the new K-9 Unit was able to gain over \$32,000 in just two weeks.

In other news, the county discussed and approved the increase in cost of their (TAC) Texas Association of Counties liability insurance policy. **The county paid \$83,000 last year** and will pay \$101,000 this year. The current burn ban has also been rescinded by a 4-1 vote. **Commissioner Rainwater explained** that the county has also sent a formal resolution opposing the proposed rail line between Burnet and Lampasas to the STB (Surface Transportation Board) outlining the reasons for opposition.

Finally, a lot of detailed discussion was had on the work being done at the courthouse by RKJ Construction including the bandstand and the 142 year old staircase spindles. **Judge Hoyer and the court appreciate** the attention to so many historic details in ensuring that the courthouse and associated repairs are done right and within the \$100,000 contingency budget for the project.

No Eggs, No Problem *Scripps News*

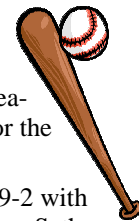

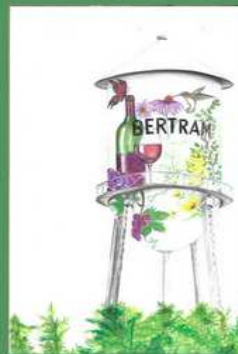
