

# **District Court Notes**

**Lampasas Courthouse was** the site of a 27<sup>th</sup> District Court Docket call on April 12, 2019. Presiding over the Court was 27<sup>th</sup> District Judge John Gauntt.



PG1 less than a gram. There were 12 cases involving possession of a controlled substance, with ten involving a gram or less, one for 1-4 grams and one for possession of 4-200 grams.

There were two DWI cases, one for DWI w/a child of 15 or under in the vehicle, and one for DWI felony repetition. There was one fraud case and one forgery case.

There were two cases for theft of a firearm and three assault cases; one for assault on a family or household member/impeding breath or circulation, one for assault on a public servant, and one for aggravated assault with a deadly weapon. There was one case for t ampering with physical evidence with intent to impair.

A suppression hearing is scheduled for Gregory Loper of Kempner on charges of bail jumping/fail to appear and possession of a controlled substance PG1 less than a gram.

Of the 27 cases presented of the court, 3 of tehm were settled. Francisca Alcozer of Copperas Cove had her probation amended to include treatment, and Melinda Rhea saw her probation extended 4 years and is required to go to treatment, and will remain in custody until transferred to the treatment center. On the charge of possession or transport of chemical with intent to manufacture a controlled substance, Jordan Miller of Lampasas saw his probation revoked and was sentenced to 3 years TDCJ with credit for time served plus court costs and attorney fees.

The balance of the cases were reset or had trials set for some future date.

Coach Doege will go to his bullpen where he has no less than six

capable pitchers, though only five of them are eligible to pitch on Tuesday.

The fans will be in Salado's bleachers at 7pm, hoping for a repeat of the Friday matchup.

Badger fans, note that the upcoming Liberty Hill game this week will be played on Thursday at 7pm in Liberty Hill.
