Expanding Texas' Urban Forests

The U.S. Department of Agriculture has awarded Texas A&M Forest Service \$21.75 million for projects that will expand and conserve forests in the state's urban areas. The funding, part of the Biden administration's Inflation Reduction Act, will help Texas expand its urban forest canopy, improve air and water quality, reduce energy consumption, and enhance the health and well-being of communities.

The funding will be used to support a range of urban forestry projects across Texas, including tree planting and maintenance, tree canopy assessments, and community engagement and education initiatives. The priorities for the funding align with the Healthy Trees, Healthy Lives initiative, which aims to raise awareness about the importance of urban forests and encourage Texans to get involved in urban forestry activities.

Urban forests provide numerous benefits, including:

- Reducing air pollution and greenhouse gas emissions
- Lowering energy consumption by providing shade and reducing heat island effects
- · Improving water quality and reducing stormwater runoff
- · Enhancing property values and economic vitality
- Improving public health and well-being

"We are thrilled to receive this funding from the U.S. Forest Service," Davis said. "This will help us continue to build more resilient and sustainable communities across Texas."
