Today: Mostly cloudy but warm, with a 79° high this afternoon. The south wind will be stiff at 15-20 mph and gusting to 20 mph.

Tonight: Cloudy and down to 67° overnight. That means 70° should be enjoyed for Tuesday evening ball games around the state this evening. The wind will be continue to be a bit much with S-SE wind at 15 mph and gusting.

Even though the weather did reduce the number of people on hand, there were still a few thousand outdoor types there, and plenty of visitor vehicle's


