## The Weather



The High yesterday 80° The Low this morning 62°

**Today:** Mostly cloudy but warm, with a 79° high this afternoon. The south wind will be stiff at 15-20 mph and gusting to 20 mph.

**Tonight:** Cloudy and down to 67° overnight. That means 70° should be enjoyed for Tuesday evening ball games around the state this evening. The wind will be continue to be a bit much with S-SE wind at 15 mph and gusting.

**Wednesday:** Here comes the one day rainy spell to Central Texas. A 40% chance of rain during the day with possible storms, otherwise mostly cloudy and up to 80° in the afternoon. The south wind will be lighter at 5-10 mph. Overnight, the rain chances are 50% and the low to 58°.

**Rest of the week:** Thursday will be back to sunny, though the arrival of the cold front that brought the rain will keep the high to 70° or so. The wind will have shifted to N-NW at 10-20 mph. Overnight it should get down to about 50°.

Friday will see the wind shift back to W-NW and the high will get up to the mid 70s.

The weekend will see the south wind back in place at 5-15 and the high temperature will get back to the mid-80s for a nice weekend.

Coach Doege will go to his bullpen again, where he has no less than six capable pitchers, though only five of them are eligible to pitch on Tuesday.

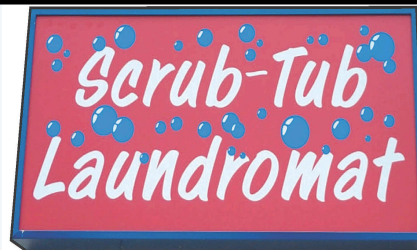
The fans will be in Salado's bleachers at 7pm, hoping for a repeat of last Friday's matchup.
