The Weather

South winds have been gusting up to 26 mph.

Today: A 20% chance of rain until early afternoon. The south wind will continue to blow 10-15 mph and gusting to 20 mph, and the temperature will be in the 70s and low 80s, probably topping out about 83°.

Tonight: Rain chances are up to 80% and it could come with storms. It is most likely to be wet up to 4am. The low should be about 58° overnight and the wind will be S-SE at 5-15 mph and gusting. This rain could bring 1/2 to 3/4 of an inch in the rain gauges.

Thursday: Shower possibilities are 30%, most likely in the early morning, then it will become sunny in the afternoon with a high near 70°. The wind will shift to N-NW and get up to 20-25 mph and gusting by afternoon.

Overnight, this new front will bring more wind, though not quite as stormy as earlier, and the temp down to 51°.
