Today: Look for mostly cloudy skies with a high near 72° and a 30% chance of showers and storms this afternoon. S-SE wind near 15 mph with possible gusts of 25 mph.

Tonight: Look for mostly cloudy skies with the low dropping to about 64° by morning. Wind will be S-SE at around 20 mph gusting to 30 mph.

Wednesday: Mostly cloudy skies with a high temperature near 82°. Look for wind to be s near 15 mph with gusts as high as 25 mph.

Wednesday Night: Look for mostly cloudy skies with a low near 66° and a S wind near 15-20 mph with possible gusts as high as 30 mph.

Lampasas Sesquicentennial

The Lampasas County Museum Board invites the public to join us to celebrate "150 years of Lampasas" this Friday at 1pm. Friday, April 21st will be declared "Lampasas Day" and the start of a year of celebration: "Lampasas Sesquicentennial Year".

Our own Mayor TJ Monroe will give the formal proclamation kicking off the sesquicentennial celebration.

The proclamation event will be outside the museum and a copy of the legislation creating the city of Lampasas will be on display. Light refreshments will be available.

The new sesquicentennial exhibit titled "Come Home to Lampasas: A Salute to Our Sesquicentennial" will open for visitors beginning on May 12th.

National Work Zone Awareness Week

Following a year in which fewer people were killed in work zone crashes in Texas, TxDOT is calling on all drivers to stay vigilant and help continue that downward trend. As National Work Zone Awareness Week kicks off, TxDOT's "Be Safe. Drive Smart." campaign is reminding drivers to stay alert and exercise caution when going through road construction and maintenance areas.

Traffic fatalities in the state's work zones were down 16% in 2022, decreasing for the first time since 2018. Despite that, 205 people lost their lives and another 788 were seriously injured in Texas work zones last year. The vast majority of those killed, 85%, were drivers or their passengers.

The "Be Safe. Drive Smart." campaign offers five tips for safely navigating work zones: (1) Slow down (2) Pay attention (3) Watch out for road crews (4) Don't tailgate and (5) Allow extra time.

TxDOT also reminds motorists of the state's Move Over/Slow Down law that requires drivers to move over a lane or reduce their speed to 20 mph below the posted speed limit when approaching TxDOT, emergency, law enforcement, tow truck or utility vehicles stopped with flashing lights activated on the roadside.

Traffic fines double in work zones when workers are present and can cost up to \$2,000. Failure to heed the Move Over/Slow Down law can also result in a fine of up to \$2,000.
