High yesterday was 70° The low this morning was 44°

Today: The sunshine and lovely spring weather will take over today. The temperature should just touch 80° this afternoon and the south will be light at 5-10 mph.

Tonight: Mostly clear, with a low around 59, and S-SE wind at 5-15 mph.

Sunday: Easter morning will be really nice with the temperature rising fast out of the upper 60s into the 70s. The afternoon high will be into the low 80s. The wind will be a little obnoxious, coming out of the south at 10-20 mph with gusts to 25.

Monday will be nice again, with an afternoon high of 81°, though a few clouds will be coming in.

Tuesday brings a 50% chance of rain, along with an afternoon high in the upper 70s.

Wednesday is the day that rain seems inevitable and that could disrupt UIL athletic playoffs in the area.

The NWS rain chance forecast is 70%, and the forecast calls for a good rainfall accumulation at that. The rain is being brought in by another front so the wind will shift from southerly to easterly and then northerly. The temperature is not likely to drop to bothersome levels, probably 73° to 58° on Wednesday, then warming up on Thursday.




