The Weather



The High yesterday 82° The Low this morning 64°

Today: "Cloudy today, rainy tamale." That's the outlook. The sunshine will be somewhere behind the cloud cover today but we won't see it. The high should be held down to 78° or so and the south wind will be brisk at 10-15 mph and gusting.

Tonight: The clouds will continue, the SE wind will be 5-15 mph, and the low will be about 64°.

Tuesday: A 40% chance of rain after 1pm, otherwise cloudy with a high around 75° and with E-SE wind 5-10 mph. Overnight Tuesday the rain chances are up to 70% with possible thunderstorms.

Rest of the week: Wednesday brings a 100% chance of rain with possibly heavy rain. The high should be near 69° in the afternoon and light wind will shift to the east. The rain chances continue into the overnight with a 60% chance as a front arrives with N-NE wind at 5-10 mph that shifts a little to the west after midnight.

Thursday will be partly sunny and held to about 76° for the high with N-NW wind 5-15 mph. Friday will be sunny with a high near 79° and it should all be back to super nice by the weekend with mid-80s temps and sunshine.
