The Weather

Today: The clouds rolled in during the wee hours this morning, and they will be with us for about three days. The cloudy forecast for today is for a 40% chance of rain this afternoon, with SE wind 5-15 mph and gusting to 20.

Tonight: A 60% chance of rain overnight, mainly after 1am, clouds, S-SE wind 5-15 mph, and a low temp of 62° .

Wednesday: A 100% chance of rain, possibly heavy rain of 1-2 inches, and 60s will be common temps with a high of about 70°. The east wind will be 5-15 mph and gusting to as much as 25. Overnight the rain is still likely, with a 70% chance, and the low temp might be about 57°.

Rest of the week: Thursday will be likely cloudy in the morning and the sun might pop out in the afternoon, though the wind will shift to N-NW bringing a little cooling after the 75° high. The morning rain chances are 20%. The evening forecast is for mostly clear with a low around 57° and the N-NW wind will be 5-10 mph.

Friday will see the generally northerly wind coming very light, the sunshine commanding the day and bringing a 78° afternoon high, but the overnight forecast will still get down to the upper 50s.
