The Weather

The winds are forecasted to remain light today and eventually shift to the south. Winds could increase to near 15 mph tomorrow in our area. A cool front is expected to move through our area tomorrow, but lacking moisture will not be a rain-maker. Temperatures this weekend should be seasonal.

Today: Sunny with a high near 83°. The wind will be W at 5-10 mph becoming N in the afternoon.

Tonight: Mostly clear with a low near 63° and a N-NE wind at 5-10 mph shifting to the S after midnight.

Friday: Sunny skies with a high temperature near 93°. Winds will be S near 15-20 mph shifting to the west in the afternoon with gusts as high as 30 mph.

Friday Night: Skies will be mostly clear with a low near 56°. Winds will be NW at 5-10 mph becoming N-NE early Saturday morning.

Saturday: Sunny skies and a high temperature will be near 78°. Winds will be N-NE at 5-15 mph.

Saturday Night: 54° with mostly clear skies, and light N-NE wind.

Golf Course Re-opens



Hancock Park Golf Course will be reopening, with restrictions in place, to members only beginning today from 7:30am-7:30pm. Beginning Monday, April 27, the golf course will be open to the public. You must have a tee time scheduled. No walk-ins will be welcome. All golfers must be off the course by 7:30pm. For

The City of Lampasas does not allow jogging, biking or fishing on the Golf Course. If you are engaging in these activities you will be asked to leave.

The following restrictions and guidelines will be in place to prevent the spread of coronavirus:

- You must schedule a tee time
- No walk-ins will be welcome
- All golfers must maintain social distance
- Golfers cannot remove or handle the flag sticks
- Rakes from bunkers will be removed
- Water fountains will not be available for use
- Ball washers will be covered
- All carts will be sanitized after each use
- All restrooms on the course will remain locked and unavailable until further notice
- Restrooms inside the Pro Shop will be available for use
- Only (2) people will be allowed in the Pro Shop at once
- No 2 for 1 coupons accepted until further notice
- No twilight fees until further notice

Businesses Reopening?

According to the Texas Tribune, Gov. Greg Abbott could make an announcement as soon as Friday about reopening a wide range of Texas businesses amid the coronavirus pandemic, including restaurants, hair salons and retail outlets.

"We are looking at counties where there have been like zero cases, or just a low number of cases ... and these would be mostly rural counties. They may be able to have an expanded version of being able to open up," Abbott said. "And then on the flip side of that, there are some counties where the outbreak is still progressing too rapidly, and they may not be able to fully participate in the initial phase of reopening until they get the spread of the coronavirus in their county under control." Some of the state's most populous counties, such as Harris and Dallas counties, remain hotspots, and local leaders there continue to harbor concerns about reopening the economy too quickly. At the same time, some rural counties have had very few or no positive tests, leading some officials there to agitate for a return to normal. Currently, Texans can patronize restaurants through takeout or delivery. Starting Friday, retailers will be able to deliver items to customers' cars or homes under the "retail-to-go" model that Abbott recently announced.

Abbott's comments Wednesday seemed to suggest that Texans would soon be able to go inside those establishments, though they would still be required to follow unspecified standards to keep the virus at bay.

In a second radio interview, Abbott said the announcement will come "either this Friday or next Monday," with the reopenings going into effect a week after the announcement. Businesses have said they need that weeklong period to "ramp up" again, according to the governor

Kindergarten Round Up

Lampasas ISD is having their annual Pre-K/Kindergarten Round Up beginning May 12th at Kline Whitis. Hanna Springs will be May 13th, and Taylor Creek will be holding their Kindergarten Round Up on May 14th. On the days specified, the schools will be open from 9am to 6pm for legal guardians to register their children. If your child will be 5 on or before September 1st 2020, they will be eligible for Kindergarten. If the child turns 4 on or before September 1st 2020, they can apply for Pre-K. Pre-K students must qualify for enrollment based on state guidelines.

Parents/Guardians should bring a copy of the students shot record, birth certificate, social security card, proof of residence, (utility bill), and a photo ID of the person enrolling the child. If you have any questions, please call the campus you will be registering at.

NOTE: Students/Children will NOT be allowed into school buildings on these days.

City Offers Assistance to Businesses

The City of Lampasas is offering businesses that have had major impacts due to the Coronavirus some assistance. There are two programs, one is from the City and one is from the Lampasas Economic Development Corp.

The city is offering a credit on the utility bills of businesses that have been affected. The credit can be for 100% or 75%. There is a committee that will grant the credits based on applications submitted to the city.

The LEDC is also offering a program, that will consist of cash grants to local businesses that have had an impact from the Coronavirus shutdown. The grant maximum is \$3000, but not everyone will receive that amount of money. It will depend on your application. It is understood that the impact to local businesses huge, and maybe these programs can be utilized as a "bridge" until greater resources can be distributed.
